The mission of the Porin Pyrintö badminton section is to offer all people, regardless of age, gender or social status, the opportunity to play badminton either competitively or as a hobby. To implement this, the section organises a mini-badminton, a badminton school, competition groups, a guided shift for adult amateurs and independent training sessions for children and young people aged 4–18. In addition, the Family Closing Shift, which is intended for badminton school children and their family members. In addition, the section organizes 1-3 competitions annually.

For competing juniors (10 – 18 years old), the club has Kilpa1 and Kilpa2 groups, where 15 – 20 talented and goal-oriented juniors train three times a week. The section's competitive players, and especially the talented junior and competition group members who have attended badminton school, have been very successful in the competitions they have participated. Porin Pyrintö badminton aims to further educate and encourage young and adult competitive players to participate in the competition field. Competition activities are supported by competition fees according to the financial situation. Section members are not charged a participation fee in their own competitions, but participation is required, for example, as a point scorer and other assistance during competitions whenever possible. During 2023, the badminton section aims to organise competitions as follows: National and Louna-Sula Junior competitions in the spring and autumn seasons.
