Subject: AIBA Extraordinary Congress 2021

Dear Presidents and Secretaries General,

I have the pleasure, on behalf of the Board of Directors to invite all AIBA eligible National Federations to attend the **next AIBA's Extraordinary Congress 2021 on December 12th, 2021, at 12:00 PM [noon] Central European Time.**

The main agenda of this Extraordinary Congress will be to implement AIBA reforms, including the preparations of the next year's AIBA electoral Congress, review of the Constitution, and adopt necessary regulations. The final agenda will be provided in due course but not later than one month prior to the Congress.

On 21 September 2021, the Board of Directors resolved that the Congress should take place in a virtual format, due to the ongoing pandemic situation and the short notice. As the date falls during the AIBA Women World Championship that will take place in Istanbul, delegates who will be on site may attend the Congress from there, but the voting will be exclusively available via a secured online voting platform.

The registration to the 2021 AIBA Extraordinary Congress starts today and will be open until **November 12th, 2021**, close of business day CET (Central European Time).

According to article 16 of the AIBA Constitution and 9 of the Membership Policy, in order to be eligible to attend the Congress, National Federations need to fulfil the requirements provided in article 16.2 of the Constitution, in particular having had at least one Boxer competing in AIBA or Continental Competitions during the previous four years before the Congress, i.e. since December 2017. Moreover, each delegate to the Congress must have been validly appointed by that delegate's National Federation in accordance with the constitution, bylaws or regulations of that National Federation. Please proceed to register your delegate(s) via [AIBA database "Congresses section"](#), make sure to fill in all requested fields, including full name as indicated on your passport and indicating which delegate is your Voting Delegate. Please bear in mind that each NF can register a maximum of one Voting Delegate and two Non-Voting Delegates (without right to vote or speak during the Congress).

Please be advised that a list of eligible federations to participate and vote at the upcoming Congress will be determined in accordance with AIBA Constitution article 16.2. A list of eligible National Federations will be published on AIBA website in due time.
