Dear Presidents and Secretaries General,

I would like to formally announce to you that the AIBA Executive Committee at its Extraordinary meeting in Geneva on June 27<sup>th</sup>, 2019 voted to convene an AIBA Extraordinary Congress (Art. 24.3 and 24.4 of the AIBA Statutes), and at its meeting in Istanbul on August 31<sup>st</sup> agreed on the new dates for this important event. This Congress will take place in Lausanne, Switzerland as per the schedule below:

13 December	Arrivals
14 December	Congress
15 December	Departures

The AIBA Executive Committee now invites each National Federation to submit reform proposal or proposals for amendment of the AIBA Statutes as that National Federation believes to be desirable. The draft proposed amendments will, in part, be designed to meet the IOC's governance reform expectations with respect to AIBA.

Because time is short, I respectfully request that all such National Federation proposals:

- (1) be kept as summary and short as possible; and
- (2) be provided by email to [congress@aiba.org](mailto:congress@aiba.org) by no later than 4.00 pm on Friday, 27 September 2019

The official agenda will be distributed accordingly to all eligible AIBA National Federations no later than one month prior to the Congress (article 25 and 26 of the AIBA Statutes). AIBA office will provide further details on the logistical aspects in the coming days.

We hope that you will reserve the date on your calendar, and we look forward to your attendance at this important meeting.
