



Mäntysaari instructions. Wellcome!

Island use and visitors

- For Merimelojat ry paddling members only.
- Guests: 5€ / day
- IBAN: FI37 2400 1800 0354 87 / reference 6149172
- Overnight stays only in tents.
- Quiet hours 22:00–07:00.

Firewood and ashes

- Firewood and tools are stored behind the sauna in the woodshed.
- Cutting down trees is forbidden.
- Using driftwood is prohibited.
- Ashes from the sauna stove must be completely cooled before being emptied into a metal bucket. Do not water the bucket; do not place it hot on the terrace.

Cleaning and departure

- Clean the sauna, cabin, and surroundings.
- Wash the floors, refill firewood, and chop small kindling safely.
- Leave ventilation vents and lockers open.
- Sign the guest book.
- Lock the doors. Close the woodshed do

Making a fire

- Open fire only at the designated fire pit and with a metal stove.
- Supervise the fire and extinguish it carefully.
- Do not put ashes in the compost.
- Smoking is allowed only at the masonry grill.

Keys and cabin

- M-key (can be collected from the office).
- Sauna key is kept in the cabin.
- No open fire or candles in the cabin.

Sauna

- Fill the stove's water tank with rainwater.
- Use rainwater for sauna water. Do not bring seawater into the sauna.
- Seawater causes the stove to rust.
- Wash using seawater.
- The floor does not tolerate water, no splashing.
- No candles.
- Bring your own light if needed..

Water, WC, waste

- Bring your own drinking water.
- Dry toilet: use peat or sawdust.
- Take all trash with you.
- Bio-waste goes into the compost..

Leave the island in good condition

- Follow general care and respect nature.
- Enjoy nature and your visit!
