We are now at the last month of our CoCoFe project. After summer holidays, the partners have finalized the main resources for female migrants' working in small-scale manufacturing and retail industry:

- The Companion Book
- The Mini-Dictionary
- The e-learning platform

Eurospeak (UK,) Center For Social Innovation (Cyprus), Learning For Integration (Finland), Solution (France) and Fundacion De Trabajadores (Spain) have translated all the resources in Spanish, Finnish, Greek and French to multiply the impact of the project by making the courses available also for people who don't speak English.



LOCAL TESTING ACTIVITIES AND EVENTS

During the past months, the project partners have implemented the CoCoFe resources in the UK, France, Spain, Cyprus and Finland. Thus, testing and training sessions with migrant women were organized in these countries focusing on the project aiming at developing their language skills.

The feedback about the CoCoFe resources were very positive! The migrant women appreciated the practical aspect of the courses including many examples, images, quizzes and exercises to practice their language skills. The e-learning dimension of the training course was welcomed, as many migrant women are mothers who haven't enough time to follow face-to-face classes.



Local events in the 5 partner countries were also organized to promote CoCoFe and its results among experts in education and in migrants' aid.
