### Project end, results, impact and conference

The NS Project is coming to an end. The last Transnational Meeting was held in Riga, Latvia on September 23 and 24, 2024 welcomed by RISEBA, Project coordinator of Naturally Sustainable.

On September 25, the final international conference was held at RISEBA bringing together industries, educators and academics from different countries. This event explored sustainable development, focusing on new approaches to education, planning and business development. Our keynote speakers and round table experts offered insights and recommendations for educators and businesses.

The results of the ERASMUS+ project "Integrating Sustainability Impact Aspects into Teaching, Learning and Student and Staff Engagement in Educational Institutions" (ref. 2021-1-LV01- KA220-VET-000025436) were presented.



The objectives of the Naturally Sustainable project in which 7 European partners participated were as follows:

1. Motivate and empower people through new training and involvement opportunities in the field of Sustainability.
2. To provide innovative solutions, teaching methods, research and practice to target groups, staff, teachers and learners in vocational and adult education;
3. To excel and extend knowledge about good practices to educational institutions and key actors in sustainability issues and activities in Europe.

The results achieved in these years of shared work with all partners will be addressed to higher, VET and adult education students, organisations active in the field of sustainability projects, organisations active in the field of youth education and training, representatives in the field of social affairs, local, regional and national public authorities and policy makers and are as follows:

1. the production of a **comparative study of activities** related to these sustainability issues, in each country/region;
2. the creation of a **collection of workshops** presenting different approaches to sustainability training and engagement activities in each country;
3. the **creation of a guide for trainers** that includes a collection of recommendations and best practices for promoting sustainability issues through training and involvement activities to empower young people;



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4. the **creation of an online learning platform** with online learning resources.

All Project partners have received, from external organizations and companies in 7 countries, their intention to use the results of the NS Project. This is very encouraging and suggests that the project has the potential to have considerable impact in the vocational training and education sector.

All resources and materials produced have been translated from English into 5 other languages-French, German, Italian, Latvian, and Finnish-in order to support and maximize the potential impact of our project throughout the European Union. They will be **freely downloadable via the website**
