*Kiel,* 2<sup>nd</sup> *December,* 2021 – START POINT begins: The European project "START POINT – Citizenship Learning in a Shifting Society" creates digital learning offers to assist marginalized young adults with their integration into our society. The project began on 1<sup>st</sup> November, 2021 and is coordinated by KulturLife and supported by European Commission under the Erasmus+ Program.

START POINT addresses disadvantaged adults between the age of 20 and 30, who will be given an understanding of their possibilities for participation in a democratic society through a free online toolkit. Therefore, the learning content will be originated with social agents and promoters of change as well as adult educators in the community and refined with participants. START POINT is a Cooperation Partnership in Key Action 2 within Adult Education. Due to international project partners the toolkit will provide contents for a diverse and multicultural audience from different European countries with individual key subjects in citizenship and helps to overcome intercultural differences. The project's main goal is to teach the participants that citizenship is the core value for social and political engagement on different local, regional, national and European levels. Thereby integration into a changing multicultural society will be easier for marginalized adults and others.
