PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENTS

The planned program contents for ISU category entries if not submitted yet must be sent by email to helsinkitrophy@hl.fi immediately. The planned content form is available on competition website.

MUSIC

All Competitors shall provide competition music of on CD (no CD-RW-s or DVD-s). CD must state the full name of the competitor, category, name of club and country. The participants are obliged to present their music records at the accreditation desk. All competitors must have an extra copy of their music available at the rink during their event. Please note that the own music for ice dance pattern dances should be also in separate CD.

COMPETITION SCHEDULE

The preliminary competition schedule can be found on the website. Please note that the schedule is likely still to be modified due to withdrawals. The schedule with starting orders will be published on the competition website on 22.9.2017 after the draw.

DRAW

The draw will be made on 22.9.2017 by a random number generator in Finnish Star Evaluation categories and by ISU Calc program in ISU categories. The result of the draw will be published on the competition website immediately afterwards. The group of pattern dances is also drawn on 22.9.2017.

Entry fees will be invoiced soon after confirmation and the invoice must be paid latest on due date **15.9.2017**.

For Finnish clubs we request that you fill out the details for electronic invoicing (OVT-tunnus ja välittäjäpankki). Should you not be able to accept invoices electronically, we need the e-mail address to which you wish to receive the invoice.

Foreign clubs will receive an invoice to the e-mail address that you have stated at enrollment. For foreign clubs only, the invoice can be paid to the bank. Please, remember to state the reference number on the invoice when paying, as this is linked to your enrollment.

In case a skater/pair has been entered in the competition, but cannot participate, she/he can be replaced by another skater in the same category and class. Participating clubs are asked to immediately inform of any changes in their entries by emailing <a href="https://example.com/heteral/heter

CANCELLATIONS

After 15.9.2017, only cancellations supported with a medical certificate will be refunded.

ACCREDITATION

The Accreditation desk will be at the Pirkkola Ice Hall.





PRACTICE ICE

There will be no practice ice available.

JUDGES

The organiser will invite the judges and the other officials and pay their expenses. The names of the judges and technical panel will be published on the competition website.

PROTOCOL / LIST OF RESULTS

Protocol/ list of results in each category will be published on the website of the competition.

PROTESTS

Protest must be submitted in writing to the Referee of the category at the latest 30 minutes after the category. The protest fee is 15 €. The Referee's decision is final.

AWARDS

The three best placed skaters in each category will be announced and awarded. All participants will receive a diploma.

EXPENSES

The organiser can not cover any expenses of the skaters.

LIABILITY

According to the ISU Regulations, Rule 119, the organiser accepts no responsibility or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury, property loss or damage suffered by the competitors or officials during the competition.

Participants are expected to have their own insurance. Such insurance must assure full medical coverage and also the return to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means of the ill or injured person.

FIRST AID

Qualified first-aid personnel will be present at the competition.

ACCOMMODATION AND TRANSPORTATION

Skaters, coaches and other team members are responsible for booking their accommodation individually if required. The organiser will not arrange transportation for participants.

CATERING

The competition venue will have a cafeteria.
