GENERAL REGULATION:

Skating A 2 Z is glad to invite you and your club to participate in BUCHAREST OPEN 2019 Recreational Skating Competition.

Participation in the Bucharest Open 2019 is open to all competitors who belong to a skating club. The international competition is open for all ages, and the skaters can enter in categories based on their skating skills and age.

TECHNICAL DATA:

Place of the competition:

Ion Tiriac- Telekom Arena Ice Rink

Drumul Garii Odai Otopeni, Romania

Rink is indoor with a surface of 60 x 30 meters, air conditioned, heated changing rooms, located near the centre of Otopeni, close to the Henri Coanda Airport.

PRESENTATION OF MEDALS

All skaters will be awarded and will receive medals, certificate of participation and present. The Award Ceremonies will take place following the finish of some categories of competitions.

EXPENSES:

The organizer covers the expenses of competition, organisation, awards, presents and board & lodging only for judges on duty. Travel expenses to and from Bucharest, transfer costs to and from the Hotel and Airport will not be covered by the organizer. The expenses for rooms and meals, travel and transfer of the Team Leaders, Competitors and other Team officials will not be covered by the organizer and are on the account of the Teams.

INSURANCE/LIABILITY:

Is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in the 3rd Bucharest Open – 2019 competition, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return of the ill or injured person to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means. The Organizer assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage in connection incurred by Competitors at Bucharest Open 19 May 2019.

MUSIC:

The music should be submitted on USB stick (one folder for all club skaters) or CD, with the name of competitor, category and event.

DRAW:

The draw will be done automatically.

PROGRAM SCHEDULE - STARTING TIMES:

Please, keep in mind that only daily starting times of the competition are fixed. Following the morning start the time schedule of the event is flexible, which means that in case of cancellations certain categories may start some time earlier than it is indicated in the Preliminary Schedule. Please, be informed that all changes in entries and Preliminary Program may be followed in the ice rink on the information board.

I. TECHNICAL PROGRAM -

- **Bronze**

Bronze	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Any two single jumps from: waltz, salchow, toe-loop, $\frac{1}{2}$ flip, $\frac{1}{2}$ lutz2. One two jump combination consisting of any of the above.3. Two foot spin or one foot spin.4. Two different spirals (examples: camel, cross-catch, catch, biellman)5. One step sequence covering at least a quarter of the ice surface	1,5 min
Silver	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Any two single jumps from: loop, flip, lutz2. One two jump combination consisting of any of the above.3. Sit spin or camel spin4. Two different spirals (examples: camel, cross-catch, catch, biellman)5. One step sequence covering at least half of the ice surface	2 min
Gold	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Any two jumps from: axel, 2salchow, 2 toe-loop2. A two jump combination/sequence, consisting of one of the jump: axel, 2salchow, 2 toe-loop3. Flying camel spin or change combination spin (change of leg and position)4. Two different spirals (examples: camel, cross-catch, catch, biellman)5. One step sequence covering at least $\frac{2}{3}$ of the ice surface	2 min
Platinum	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Any two double jumps from: loop, flip, lutz2. A two jump combination/sequence, consisting of one of the jump: 2 loop, 2 flip, 2 lutz3. Flying sit spin or Flying change combination spin (change of foot and position)	2,5 min

4. Two different spirals (examples: camel, cross-catch, catch, biellman)
5. One step sequence covering full ice surface

NOTES:

- Each individual jumps can be repeated twice. Best attempt will be judged.
- Spins with a position must have at least 6 revolution; combination spins must have at least 3 revolutions each position.
- Spirals must have a minimum of 3 seconds long each.
- There is no penalty for skating under the prescribed time or for exceeding it (30 seconds maximum)
- There are no difficulty levels.
- Judging criteria includes: jumps correctness, spins correctness, steps and edges correctness, variety of moves, posture, choreography and structure of the program, presentation.

II. SHOW SKATING *(All levels)*

This is an entertaining and fun program that requires show and theatrical abilities of the skaters. There are no marks for technical elements and the judging include music, originality, creativity, choreography, interpretation, costumes and props.

Skaters are encouraged to use props to help them skate their story, but they need to carry them on the ice by themselves in maximum 30 seconds. Fire and props that can harm the ice are not allowed.

Skaters will be judged on their ability to interpret the music and develop a theme by using their skating skills. Credit for technical elements is based solely on the ability of such movements to enhance the chosen theme and support the music. Credit will not be given for their technical difficulty.

There is no penalty for skating under the prescribed time for exceeding it (30 seconds maximum).

III. REQUIRED ELEMENTS (no music)

1. Beginners

- Coral
- Pearl
- Diamond

2. Advanced

- Bronze
- Silver
- Gold
- Platinum

Skaters execute only the elements chosen by the organizers. The elements can be done in any order with a minimum of connecting steps. Each elements can be done once only and judged; any other attempt will not be considered and there will be no penalty. .

- 1 minutes is allocated to execute the elements.

Elements:

Beginners	Coral	3 forward swizzle; 3 two foot jump in place; 1 snowball; 1 foot gliding (left and right)
	Pearl	3 backwards swizzle; 2 jumps on two feet with half rotation; forward drag (lounge); 2 foot spin
	Diamond	Forward and backwards cross-over (one circle each direction; 8 shape)/ 3 waltz steps (each direction)/ 1 foot spin
Bronze		Salchow / Cross foot spin / Forward spiral (straight or on the circle)
Silver		Flip / Sit spin / Backward spiral (inside or outside edge)
Gold		Axel / Layback Spin/ Split Jump
Platinum		2 Loop / Flying Camel / Spread Eagle or Ina Bauer

IV. BEGINNERS:

- Coral
- Pearl
- Diamond

The program will be 1 minute long and there are no required elements. The skaters can use props to support the music, will not be judged and they will all receive a medal and a certificate of participation.

V. JUMPS AND SPINS –Bronze / Silver / Gold / Platinum (no music)

Two skaters will take the ice as a team.

First skater will execute 2 x the chosen jump from the list, followed by the second skater who will execute 2x the chosen spin from the list. The best execution from each of the 2 attempts will be awarded (Jump and Spin).

There will be judged the quality of the element; difficult positions are not taken into consideration (Broken leg, jumps with hands above head, etc)

All elements will be executed in the designated area of the rink.

If two skates from different category will team up, the team will compete in the higher category

2 minutes are allocated per team to execute the jumps and spins.

Level	Jumps	Spins
Bronze	Salchow or Toe-Loop	2 foot spin or 1 foot spin
Silver	Flip or Loop	Sit spin or backwards spin
Gold	2 Salchow or 2 Toe-Loop	Camel spin or flying camel spin
Platinum	2 Loop or 2 Flip	Flying sit spin or Back entry Camel Spin

VI. ENSEMBLE (GROUP NUMBER)

The skaters have to present an entertaining program in group of minimum of 2 and maximum of 25 skaters. There will be judged the music, originality, creativity, expression, costumes and accessories. There will be no marks awarded for technical elements.
