Figure Skating Club Etelä-Vantaan Taitoluistelijat (EVT), Finland, has the pleasure of inviting your skaters to participate in the international figure skating competition **EVT Trophy 2017** to be held in Vantaa, Finland. All clubs and members of the National Figure Skating Federations associated with the ISU are invited to take part in the competition.

Competition will be held in for Debutants girls and boys.

Classes may be split into categories based on age groups.

DEBUTANTS A class Born 1.7.2004 or younger ISU Evaluation

Free Skating: Girls 3 min.(+/- 10 sec.)

Free Skating: Boys 3.30 min (± 10 sec.)

Requirements according to the Finnish Skating Union.

The Organizer has the right to split categories into age groups, if the number of participants requires it.

REGISTRATION OF ENTRIES:

ENTRY FEES:

60 EUR for ISU Skaters

Entry fee will be invoiced upon preliminary registration (i.e. right after you have received a confirmation on participation)

Entry fees are not refunded. Only cancellations verified by medical certificate (delivered latest 26.9.2017) will be refunded. Teams should inform of any changes in their team as soon as possible to

AWARDING

Three first standings of each category/class will be awarded with a cup.

PROTESTS

Each team has the right to submit protest against the judges' decision. Protests must be submitted to the Referee of the relevant event at the latest immediately after the event. Upon the submission of the protest a protest fee of 30 EUR must be paid. The referee's decision is final. In the new ISU judging systems no protests can be filed against the judges, but against the right determination of the executed element.

MUSIC

Music will be played from mp3 files.

Mp3 files equipped with the full name of the competitor, club and category must be submitted by September 9th to the following e-mail:

Discs (CD, no CD-RW or DVD) equipped with the full name of the competitor, club and category must be submitted to the announcers desk before the competition as normal CD's.

PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT

The Sheet must be completed in English using the terminology listed in ISU Communication 1494 or any update.

DRAW:

The official public draw will be held on Tuesday, September 19th, 2017 at Hanna's café in the Myyrmäki Ice Rink.

The result will be published on the official web page of the competition latest on September 20th, 2017.

JUDGING:

In Debutant classes skaters are judged by using the ISU judging system. The organizer will invite the judges and pay their expenses. Composition and manning of the panel of judges, technical panel and other officials is determined and appointed by the Organizer. Please note that the panels do not necessarily meet all the requirements of National Figure Skating Federations, e.g NISA, for ranking of qualifying purposes.

EXPENSES:

The Organizer does not pay any expenses of the teams. Travel expenses, board and accommodation will be borne by the participants.
