Competition licenses

<u>All licenses will be purchased via https://www.suomisport.fi</u> before participating in the competition. You will find different options of licenses, choose the best option what suits for you.

<u>All players must have a license to participate in the competition.</u> The license is compulsory due to the Federation accident insurance and the licensing of players. <u>The player must also be a member of a Finnish Billiard Federation</u> (SBiL) member club when purchasing a license.

A new license has been issued with a 10 € B-license, valid only in the pool and pyramid challenge series. In a pool, a player may deduct that 10 € when participating in his/her first competition. For more information on licenses, please visit https://www.sbil.fi/liitto/lisenssit/
