LOCATION AND PARKING

The show will be held at Tuomarinkylän Vinttikoirakeskus, Tuomarinkyläntie 1, Helsinki. Parking is free in designated areas. When parking your car, please be mindful of other people using the parking area. NOTE: The unloading area is not for parking – it is for unloading only! The show rings are located outdoors on grass. Tents are not allowed within the ring area but may be set up in designated areas. There must be at least 2 meters of space between tents for walkways.

SHOW SCHEDULE AND PROCEDURE

Judging will begin in staggered times; in Ring 1 at 10:00 AM and in Ring 2 at 10:15 AM. The showground opens at 8:00 AM. Exhibitors are responsible for bringing their dogs to the ring at the correct time. NOTE: Written critiques will be provided only for the top five (5) placements in each class. As not all dogs will receive written critiques, judging will proceed more quickly. Please be ready at the ringside when your dog's class begins – thank you! All class winners, including puppies, will participate in the Best Male / Best Female competition.

- Veteran (7–under 10 years)
- Special Veteran (over 10 years)
- Fiel Trial (dogs awarded in NOME-B/WT/A field trials)

EXHIBITOR NUMBER AND CATALOGUE

You will receive your exhibitor number at the information desk upon arrival. Each participant will receive a Club Show 2025 –magazine, which includes the show catalogue. The catalogue will also be published online on the morning of the show at the website *labradori.fi*.

PRIZES AND PHOTOGRAPHY

Class winners will be photographed by the Finnish Labrador Retriever Club, so please make sure to go for your photo. All prizes will be awarded in the rings – prizes will not be mailed afterwards.



REGULATIONS AND GUIDELINES

The show complies with the regulations and recommendations of the authorities and the guidelines of the Finnish Kennel Club. Any updates will be posted on *labradori.fi* and on Facebook.

The show complies with the Finnish Kennel Club's rules on identification, vaccinations and anti-doping. Vaccinations may be checked at random. If a dog is disqualified due to missing identification or incomplete vaccinations, the entry fee will not be refunded.

GET TOGETHER

At the end of the show, we will host a Get Together event with light snacks and refreshments. Please stay after the show to share your experiences, catch up with fellow exhibitors and enjoy the company!

There will be two food trucks on-site throughout the day. From these trucks you can buy hot meals, savory snacks and sweet treats with coffee.

DOG WELFARE AND HEALTH AT DOG SHOWS

Please remember that the welfare and health of dogs must always be a top priority at dog shows, and the dog's welfare is the responsibility of the exhibitor. A dog's health and well-being must not be compromised. For example, dogs must not be left in a car in hot or cold weather, nor kept for extended periods in a small cage or transport crate. Fresh water must always be available for the dog. It is not permitted to try to influence a dog's performance before or during the show by using any chemical substances, medications, or treatment procedures. For example, dyeing the dog's coat, skin, or nose, or altering the quality or shape of the coat using chemicals before or during the show is forbidden.

Dogs must never be treated harshly in any situation. In the show ring, the dog must be presented in a way that does not make it feel uncomfortable. Dogs must not be pulled or lifted by the leash. The dog owner must also ensure that the dog's behavior at the show does not pose a danger to other dogs or people.

Violation of these guidelines may result in the disqualification of the exhibitor or removal of the dog from the competition.
