



WCV Season Info 2026-2027

Thank you to all athletes, guardians, coaches, and volunteers for the past 2025–2026 season! Now it is time to turn our eyes toward the new season. This bulletin contains important information regarding registrations for the 2026–2027 season, as well as team selections for the competitive and elite teams.

Season 2026–2027

The operational season 2026–2027 begins on August 1, 2026, and ends on July 31, 2027. The training season begins in week 33 and ends on May 30, 2027. Exceptions to this are the Finnish Championship (SM) level teams, which conclude their training season at the SM Competitions on June 13, 2027.

Registration for the 2026–2027 season teams opens on **June 10, 2026, at 18:00**. Registration for the teams is done via MyClub. Everyone, including current athletes, must register for the upcoming season.

Tryouts for competitive and representative teams

Tryouts for competitive and representative teams listed below; for other teams, registration is done directly via MyClub. If an athlete does not get into their primary team of choice, they are guaranteed a spot in a team that does not require a placement session.

NOTE: No team placement sessions will be held for the Mini age group. Instead, athletes will be placed into teams by the coaches. See more info below.

Team selections for competitive and elite teams are organized as follows:

- **Juniors (Iron and Fusion):** August 3, 2026, from 17:00 to 21:00
- **Youth (Quicksilver, Copper, and Indium):** August 4, 2026, from 17:00 to 20:30
- **Adults (Platinum):** August 5, 2026, from 18:00 to 21:00 (

Minis

The club's board has ruled that no team placement sessions will be organized for mini-aged athletes for the 2026–2027 season. The team division for Minis will happen as follows:

1. The coaches of the Mini teams, together with a board member, will review current athletes and recommend a team for each individual.
2. Based on these recommendations, we will build the teams and automatically transfer athletes who trained during the 25–26 season into the upcoming 26–27 season teams.
3. Notification of the team placement will be sent via email by week 31 at the latest. If the assigned team is not suitable or you have decided to stop the hobby, please contact us by email at wcvtoimisto@gmail.com.

If there are remaining spaces in the teams, the open spots will be made available for athletes from outside the club to apply.

We primarily recommend athletes born in 2015 to train in the Minis division.

Fees

Membership and Season Fees:

- Every member of the club must pay the club membership fee, which is **40 euros**.
- In addition, each team has a season fee, which is invoiced twice a season, once in the autumn and once in the spring.
- The amount of the season fee is based on the team's level and training hours. The season fees for each team can be found in MyClub under the team descriptions and on the club's website: <https://www.vikingscheerleaders.fi/joukkueet/>.
- A **10% family discount** is granted on season fees for those living in the same household. It is possible to apply for a **10% student discount** on the season fee for higher education students (send application and certificate to wcvtoimisto@gmail.com).
- Our club's head coaches and coaches receive a **-30% discount** on the season fee of the team in which they themselves train.
- Our club's assistant coaches receive a **-15% discount** on the season fee of the team in which they themselves train. Please carefully read the following document: WCV CHEERLEADERS | LASKUTUSKÄYTÄNNÖT (INVOICING PRACTICES).

Gear Fees:

- All teams can order a team shirt and a hair bow. In recreational teams, ordering gear is optional, and the cost is a maximum of 30 euros per season.
- In competitive teams, gear fees are 50–70 euros, and in elite teams, a maximum of 100 euros.

License*:

- Everyone practicing in a member club of the Finnish Cheerleading Federation (SCL) (athletes aged 7 and older) must have either a recreational or competitive license.
- Hobbyists aged 7 and older must have a hobbyist license. The license can be purchased without insurance (price 15 euros) or with insurance (price 50–95 euros).
- The competitive license starts from 65 euros.

*Note: This information applies to the 2025–2026 season. We will update the information as soon as we receive current details from the sports federation. We assume that license prices will remain the same or nearly the same.

Another note regarding licenses: the license is purchased under a specific club. If an athlete switches clubs during the season, the price for a club transfer on levels A and B is 40–50 euros (this is also the 2025–2026 season price, which is subject to change).

Other Costs:

- Competitive teams have camps led by external coaches. The camps cost approximately 70 euros per camp.
- Competition trips cost approximately 80–100 euros if conducted as a day trip, and approximately 180–200 euros if the trip includes a hotel overnight stay.
- Competitive teams pay a uniform rental fee to the club of 5–20 euros per competition.

Fundraising

Club Fundraising:

- The club will organize one fundraising campaign during the 26–27 season, which is mandatory for every athlete. The format of the autumn fundraising will be decided before the start of the season.
- Family discounts are granted for club fundraising for individuals living in the same household.

Team Fundraising:

- Teams can organize their own fundraising to help offset competition fees, for example. Teams will agree on the season's fundraising during the parents' evening held at the beginning of the season.
