

# Billing

## **The RHYTHMIC GYMNASTICS coaching group fee includes:**

A. Membership fee 30 € / year 2020-2021

B. Operating fee (35 € -290 € / month 2020-2021)

\* coaching fee

\* hall fee

\* administration fee

C. Competition and camp fees (according to participation)

D. Additional training (according to participation)

E. "RV Iltis" afternoon club Fee (optional, billed monthly)

F. "RV Iltis" afternoon club Transportation Fees (optional, billed monthly)

### **A. MEMBERSHIP FEE**

1. 30 € / year

2. Paid once a season

3. Always paid on the first invoice.

4. If you start in a group in the fall then the membership fee will be paid for the entire coming season 1.8.-31.7.

5. If you start for the first time only in the spring season, a membership fee of 30 € will still be paid, in which case the membership benefits will be available on 31.7. until.

7. The membership fee includes e.g. Teosto and Gramex fees, website maintenance fee, Finnish Gymnastics Association membership fees, advertising and information costs

### **B. OPERATING FEE**

1. € 35 - € 290 per month 2020-2021 (per group)
2. Includes the following areas
  - Coaching fee
  - Hall fee = 11 € -41 € / month 2020-2021
  - Administration fee = 19-22 € / month 2020-2021
  - Ballet exercises and physical training are included in the operating fee

### C. COMPETITION AND CAMP FEES

1. Before / after the competitions will be charged to those competitors who have REGISTERED for the competitions. If you are unable to participate in the competition, you will receive a refund (minus office expenses) with your medical certificate.

#### 2. INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING AREAS:

- Competition entry fee

The club pays the organizing club for the costs of organizing the competitions (facilities, music, food, prizes, etc.)

- Judge and coach fees

The fee covers the costs of the judges and coaches participating in the competitions for the club. Judges and coaches will not be paid on the day of the competition, but will receive travel, accommodation and subsistence expenses as compensation for their time in the competitions to support and assist the girls. These adult costs of the competitions will be collected and shared among all the competitors of the SVS clubs who have participated in the competitions.

All information related to the national competitions (invitations, schedules, lists of participants, performance orders / links to them, results in real time) can be found in the Gymnastics Association's Competition Service

Information on the clubs' own competition events can be found at from the club's own website.

If you know that you will not be able to take part in any of the competitions during the season due to travel, etc., please notify your coach immediately. It is not possible to participate in all competitions due to other activities, eg due to shows or due to the absence of a judge, for example. SVS clubs recommend active participation in all age groups during the competition period.

Post-registration may be possible, the post-registration fee is double.

## PARTICIPATION FEE FOR COMPETITIONS AND CAMPS

You can register for the club's camps through the member information service HOIKA. The coach will do the registration to the competitions.

Those selected for the Finnish Gymnastics Association's coaching rings will be granted a grant of 30 € per camp by decision of the club boards, which will be deducted in the club's next bill.

The club pays the participation fees to the organizing club according to the registrations.

Entry fees and the share of coach / judge costs will be invoiced per competition.

**Proportion of coach / judge costs:** for each competition, each club must state the number of unrestricted judges based on the participants 'rules according to the association's judges' rules at the risk of a judge's fine (€ 150 / day / missing judge).

Club judges and coaches are not paid for competition and camp times, but expenses are reimbursed 100%. Costs will be shared equally between competitors who participated on the same weekend (regardless of the date of participation).

The gymnast's coach and judge's expenses will be invoiced in the same invoice as the participation fee.

## IN CASE OF ILLNESS

If a gymnast registered for competitions/camps get sick after registration, a medical certificate must be presented to the organizing club and his own club in order for the registration fee to be refunded. However, the organizing club charges an office fee of 10 €.

If a gymnast already registered for the competitions/camps decides not to go to the competition or camp for a reason other than illness, the registration fee will not be refunded and will be paid by the gymnast / team. In this case, a part of the coach and referee costs must also be paid.

## FOREIGN AND DOMESTIC COMPETITION AND CAMP FEES

Participants pay their own competition and travel expenses. Participants will also pay for the travel, accommodation and subsistence expenses of the outgoing coach and judge, which will be shared between the outgoing competitors.

Depending on the case, the judge's and coach's expenses are paid by the club and the gymnast's travel expenses can also be supported at the national team / Finnish Championship level.

Primarily, competitions under FIG are supported and support is targeted in ranking order.

The club's support for the training costs of domestic and foreign camp coaches is 50-100%.

Please remember to check the insurance coverage of a competitor going abroad.

## TEAM COSTUME AND EQUIPMENT PAYMENTS

Rules for team, duo / trio and individual costumes and equipment:

The club provides significant support to teamwork, both in terms of commissioning and coaching programs and music.

For equipment and costumes, the team can choose from the three options below.

The club commissions team uniforms and lends them to gymnasts in team competitions. Team uniforms cannot then be borrowed for individual performance. The club also acquires the necessary equipment for the teams, which will be used in team drills and competitions - they will be collected at intervals. The team equipment fee is collected from the gymnasts participating in the teams once the costs have been determined and is paid as a one-off and is valid as long as the gymnast is on the team.

**1) New suits and equipment: the team fee is 40% of the cost**

The team's equipment fee is 40% of the cost of purchasing new suits or equipment. The suits and equipment are the property of the club and remain with the club.

**2) The team pays 100% of the costumes and equipment itself: no team fee**

It can be agreed on a team-by-team basis that the gymnasts procure and publish the suits themselves, in which case the suits / equipment are the gymnasts' own and no team fee is charged. Then the costumes / equipment can also be used freely in individual competitions.

**3) The team has used equipment and suits: fee 30 euros / gymnast**

The equipment fee for teams that gymnast with used club-owned suits and equipment is 30 euros / gymnast. Suits and equipment are the property of the club.

**4) TEAM suits**

The sleeveless simple TEAM suit with logo for the younger age groups is suitable for the lower class team and duo / trio programs. The costume for the costume is 15 € / season (autumn / spring).

**D. ADDITIONAL TRAINING EXPENSES**

1. Invoiced separately as agreed and according to usage
2. Ancillary costs include additional exercises instructed by the coach, eg additional ballets, mental coaching, nutrition guidance.

Ballet and physical training included in the number of hours per week are not billed separately, but are included in the coaching fee. Ballet and physics training in excess of the number of hours per week will be billed separately and with prior notice.

**MUSCLE BALANCE SURVEYS, NUTRITION LECTURES, MENTAL LECTURES**

Physiotherapy, muscle balance surveys, nutrition and mental lectures provided by professionals in the field are offered to members on a group-by-group basis during the year of operation, if necessary. These events will be announced in advance and participants will be billed in advance. The events are scheduled either at the beginning or end of the operating year, separate from the competition season.

**PHYSIOTHERAPY, MASSAGE, SPORTS DOCTOR SERVICES, MENTAL TRAINING**

You can also contact professionals in the field through the club, if necessary, contact us via the form on the front page. Expenses are taken care of directly by yourself.

# Terms of payment for coaching groups

## 1) GETTING TO KNOW THE GROUP

**The gymnast can try twice for the price of the membership fee** and several times as agreed separately, if the training is suitable for her (= trial period), after which the gymnast must decide whether to participate in the activity for the whole period (= six months, autumn / spring). At the end of the trial period and when committing to gymnastics in the club's coaching group, the gymnast follows the instructions and rules of the Gymnastics Association and the SVS club. A normal group fee will be paid for the trial period.

## 2) COMMITMENT to activities throughout the autumn / spring season

2.1.) The gymnast commits to participate in the coaching activities organized by the club in principle for the entire year of operation. Commitment to the entire season is important for the club to be able to hire professional coaches, and it requires a guarantee of long-term solvency. By registering with the coaching group, you commit to the club's payment policies and to paying the expenses reported for the groups.

2.2.) A place in the coaching group is secured by registering for the next season by the end of May and paying an advance

2.3.) The operating period is 1.07.2020-18.06.2021 in Espoo and Helsinki. The Christmas break for the coaching groups is 21.12.2020-06.01.2021.

2.4.) Pre-coaching "Esivalmennus" groups can start at the coach's proposal later will be taken into account in the annual price.

## 3) STARTING IN THE MIDDLE OF THE SEASON

A later start after the start of the season does not entitle you to a deduction for the coaching fee, but the entire group pays the same fee right from the start, unless expressly agreed in writing in advance with the club's invoicing. Just notification about the situation is not enough.

Exception 1:

For pre-training groups "Esivalmennus", the start can take place later, agreed separately.

Exception 2:

New gymnasts who register later will only pay from the start month, for August, mid-pay is also possible.

#### 4) PAYMENT

The operating fee is always paid at the beginning of the billing period.

It includes the coaching fee, the administration fee and the hall fees, which are invoiced in monthly installments before the month of the activity in question or at the latest at the end of the period.

You can participate in the exercises when all payments have been made by the due dates.

Any additional training and invoices related to competition/camps will be invoiced according to the registration. Competition participation fees and the gymnast's share of the common coach and judge's expenses will be invoiced in the same invoice.

#### 4.1.) EFFECT OF HOLIDAYS ON THE TRAINING FEE:

Autumn holidays, Christmas holidays, winter holidays and Easter, as well as other public holidays, are taken into account when determining the fee. Thus, the monthly operating fee may be the same even if the month includes September / Christmas / winter / Easter holidays or other public holidays, and even if the competition/show/camp or the variation of available hall shifts due to municipal decisions would cause changes in the schedule.

Near of holiday periods, classes are held in joint groups and trainings can take place outside the normal halls (especially May, June, August and December).

During the holidays, the aim is to offer optional camping.

#### 4.2.) EFFECT OF OWN HOLIDAYS OR INCIDENTAL ABSENCES ON THE TRAINING FEE

No refund. Long absences: The deductible period in cases of illness against a medical certificate and, for example, for absences for long trips abroad **is three weeks**, after which the billing ceases.

#### 4.3.) SUMMER AND OTHER HOLIDAY ACTIVITIES

Any activities that take place during the holidays will be billed separately.

#### 4.4.) EFFECT OF CHANGING THE AGE CLASS ON THE TRAINING FEE:

At the turn of the year, when moving to a new age group and increasing the number of coaching hours, a fee according to the new age group will be paid from January. At the request of the family and on the recommendation of the coach, you can stay in the younger age group until the end of the spring season.

2019: 2011 From Minies to Children, 2009 From Children to Prejuniors, 2007 From Prejuniors to Juniors

2020: 2012 From Minies to Children, 2010 to Prejuniors, 2008 to Juniors

2021: 2013 From Minies to Children, 2011 to Prejuniors, 2009 to Juniors

Please note: hobby coaching groups "Harrastevalmennusryhmät" offer coaching in all ages and at a lower price with reduced attendance. You can join hobby coaching groups at any time during the season with the permission of the head coach.

Billing will change when you change groups from the following month.

#### 4.5.) SIBLING AND FAMILY DISCOUNT

Register for the group normally and contact the office for a 10% sister discount! The discount is granted for a lower fee.

#### 4.6.) PAYMENT DIFFICULTIES

If necessary, contact the office well in advance of the due date in the event of temporary / unexpected payment difficulties and to draw up a payment plan!

Make sure you are eligible / whether your child is eligible for hobby support provided by the city.

### 5) TRAINING

#### 5.1.) CHANGES IN TRAINING SCHEDULES:

Hall shifts received from cities are standard as a rule between September 1 and April 30, at other times the summer / Christmas exception order applies. The aim is to organize the classes as far as possible at the same times. Exception order or cancellations of city shifts do not affect the amount of the coaching fee. The club aims to provide replacement / extended exercises to replace the canceled ones - primarily in their hometown and alternatively in sister club exercises.

Based on the coaching group registrations, the size of the training group, possible combined exercises of the groups, as well as the exact training locations and training times are determined.

#### 5.2.) REFUSAL/DENIAL OF ACCESS TO THE TRAINING:

Only those gymnasts can participate in the trainings who have paid the bills. If, despite the reminder, payments have not been made within two weeks or a payment plan has been made, the coach is not allowed to allow the gymnast to attend the class before the invoices for the period have been paid.

### 6.) TERMINATION/QUITTING

#### DISCUSSION WITH THE COACH

If a gymnast begins to consider ending gymnastics in the coaching group in the middle of the season, the matter should be discussed with the head coach before a formal decision is made.

#### MAPPING THE OPTIONS

The discussion explains the gymnast's situation, in which case it is possible to make the necessary changes either in coaching or to offer other hobby options in the club.

## **PAYMENT OF FEES**

If a gymnast quits in a coaching group in the middle of an activity year

- for reasons other than medical evidence of long-term illness
- to another locality (more than 100 km) due to relocation
- the club is unable to offer any other hobby group in the club

### **payments must be pay as follows:**

(a) operating fee (total fee for training, hall and administration fees)

will be paid in full until the end of the operational period (= autumn or spring), regardless of the date of termination. After the autumn season, termination must be announced by 30.11.

b) payments related to competitions and camps and related training are invoiced until the end of the month following the month of termination (= 1 month notice period).

(c) In addition, gymnasts at the International and Championship levels will reimburse the club for all subsidies for competition, camping, additional training, transportation or ancillary training during that period of operation and return the Sponsored Equipment and Leotards.

It is not possible to use programs commissioned by the club without permission and compensation after the change of club.
