10. Competition Mode

The competition will be conducted in accordance with the latest IJF Refereeing rules.

Competition systems according to number of participants:

6 and more entries: Double repechage

3,4,5 entries: Round robin

2 entries: better of 2 fights, if 1-1 the third match will decide

11. **Draw**

The draw will take place on Saturday before the age category starts.

12. Weigh-in

Official weigh-in for each weight category is held the evening before the competition day or in the competition day morning (see program). Athletes must present their passport (National ID Cards showing nationality, photo and date of birth are also accepted).
