## Oral presentations, short oral presentations and poster pitch talks

### General note

The schedule is tight! Focus on the key points and avoid sharing too many details with the audience. If you run over time, we may need to cut your talk.

Remember, most people spend a minimum of 1 minute per slide on average. Especially if you have a lot of slides in your presentation, it would be helpful to consider in advance which slides and bullet points you can skip if time runs short.

Please sit in the front rows of the meeting room during the session where you will be presenting.

### The time reserved for presentations:

**Oral presentations (OP):** 7 minutes including some questions/comments from the audience

**Short oral presentations (SO):** 3 minutes including max one question/comment

**Poster pitch talk (P):** 1.5 minutes max (but don't hesitate to be quicker!). The purpose of your pitch is not to tell the entire story and every detail of your poster, but to spark the audience's interest so they will visit your work in the exhibition area later and ask detailed questions. Even if there isn't a formal presentation in front of your poster, please be prepared to stand by it during the next coffee break after your pitch talk (poster exhibition) to discuss your work further. See the session timing details below.

Please note that there will be no time for discussion during the pitch talk; discussions will take place in front of your poster.
