# Environment

- Nature is appreciated in Finland
  - Very little trash in nature
- Pure air
  - Many forests as carbon sinks
  - Fewer inhabitants than in Italy
- Well-working recycling system in both countries

# Income

- Average income
  - Finland: 3 807€
  - Italy: 2 963€
- Women's "euro" in Finland: 84cents
- In 2022 women earned about 2,7 thousand euros less than men in Italy.
- More differences in income between people in Italy
- Taxes:
  - There is more strict taxation in Finland, because of the progressive taxation
