

△ ITF OFFICIAL INTEGRATED PLATFORM AND TOURNAMENT SYSTEM

Since the adoption of the ITF Regulation on the ITF Online Platform with the Integrated Database by the ITF EB in September, 2020, the ITF has successfully tested and launched a multi-user platform that consists of several integrated modules: Database, Secretarial Program, Event Management, Scoring System, Cyber Arena and ITF.TV

This single ecosystem with CFs, NGBs/AGBs, regional federations, schools and clubs, includes:

- Personal accounts of athletes, coaches, referees, officials of federations and clubs with restricted access levels;
- Collection, processing and storage of historical and current data;
- Filtering data by a variety of parameters - gender, age, skill level, statuses, documents, and others;
- Tracking the ITF ranks and recognitions and the history of their issuance;
- Automation of licensing and membership fees, fees for participating in competitions, for certification and seminars;
- Document flow automation - applications, generation of certificates of attestation, seminars, final protocols of the competitions;
- Customizable mass communication - automation of email communications and in-system notifications;
- Customizable reporting and statistics;
- Displaying help information about local clubs for the public.

From the 1st of January, 2022 and as specified in Article 6. of the ITF Regulation, Tournament and Organizing Committees of any official events in ITF Taekwon-do, including Continental Championships & World Championships, must use the ITF DB Integrated Tournament system only.

ITF DB integrated Events and Tournament System provides:

- 1) Creation and customization of events of different types: competitions, certifications, seminars;
- 2) Support of the doping controls with regard to the athletes by feeding a database with integrated information;
- 3) Support of the epidemic controls and ITF Medical Committee requirements*;
- 4) Creation of an organizing committee and formation of requirements for participants according to the General Infopack;
- 5) Formation of team and individual applications for competitions;
- 6) Collecting information about arrival time and accommodation;
- 7) Accreditation of participants and guests of events;

- 8) Automation of the work of referees and competition secretaries;
- 9) Automation of drawing lots, weighing and other event procedures;
- 10) Formation and management of the event schedule;
- 11) Integration with the event scoreboard for data output;
- 12) Integrated scoring system and integration capabilities for the third-party scoring systems;
- 13) Multithreaded transmission of event progress data for content consumers;
- 14) Tools for the work of referees at the event;
- 15) Generation of the official single standard final protocols of the competitions;
- 16) Display of up-to-date information about tournaments for spectators;
- 17) Integration with video content providers, YouTube and Facebook for live streaming of tournaments through the ITF.TV channel.

*To ensure compliance with formal regulations imposed in each country along with the ITF-led self-regulatory approaches, all the members wishing to participate in any international events will have to upload their valid Medical Certificates of good Health, WADA e-learning Certificates, Vaccination Certificates and/or the PCR tests (if needed) directly to their ITF DB personal profile.
