Confirmation of the International Figure Skating Competition

The Figure Skating Club Tikkurilan Taitoluisteluklubi ry, Vantaa, Finland is pleased to confirm your skaters' participation in Tikkurila Winter Trophy, an international figure skating competition.

The competition will be held in the following single skating categories and classes:

Basic Novice younger girls (born after 1.7.2008), FS
Basic Novice older girls (born 1.1.2007-30.6.2008), FS
Intermediate Novice girls, FS
Advanced Novice girls, SP & FS
Junior Ladies, SP & FS
Senior Ladies, SP & FS
Basic Novice boys, FS
Intermediate Novice boys, FS
Advanced Novice boys, SP & FS
Junior men, SP & FS

In all categories, the ISU judging will be applied.

ISU rules will be followed in the competition. Teams from abroad are encouraged to contact the Organizer for more information.

Skaters: *The list of confirmed skaters has been posted on the competition website. If an accepted skater cannot compete, please inform the Organizer as soon as possible by e-mail (kilpailut.ttk@gmail.com)*

Planned program content:

The planned program content, if not submitted yet, should be sent by email to kilpailut.ttk@gmail.com.

Music: *Music of all competitors, if not sent yet, should be sent by e-mail to kilpailut.ttk@gmail.com. The file should preferably be in mp3 format. Naming convention to be applied is Lastname_Firstname_SP or Lastname_Firstname_FS. We appreciate if the music files can be sent in a consolidated manner by the club, not separately by each individual skater.*

CD's should also be brought to the ice rink upon arrival, but the Organizer's intention is to use them solely as a fall back plan. The music recordings should state the full name of the skater, category and the name of the club and country.

Schedule: *The preliminary competition schedule can be found on the website. Please note that the schedule is likely still to be updated closer to the competition. Schedule updates, if any, will be provided after the draw, and a more detailed schedule will be published in connection with the confirmation of the warm-up groups.*

Warm-up time will be 4 minutes for Basic Novice categories, 5 minutes for Intermediate Novice FS and Advanced Novice SP. Warm-up time will be 6 minutes in Junior ladies SP and FS, Senior ladies SP and FS also for Basic Novice boys, Intermediate Novice boys as they will be placed in same warm up group as Advanced Novice boys and Junior men. We will follow a flexible timetable throughout the competition.

Free skating:

Free skating programs in Advanced Novice, Junior and Senior will be skated in the reverse order of the short program results. All skaters will be admitted to the free skating competition.

Practice: *Practice ice will be organized for teams abroad, who have expressed their interest in the entry form. Practice ice will be on Saturday and Sunday morning and the schedule will be updated closer to competition.*

Draw: *The draw will take place on February 1, 2019 and will be performed with the ISUCalc software. The result of the draw will be published on the website.*

Entry fee: Entry fee/skater

Participants from Finnish clubs

- Basic Novice 40 euro/skater
- Intermediate Novice 45 euro/skater
- Advanced Novice 60 euro/skater
- Junior 60 euro/skater
- Senior 60 euro/skater

In addition, for participants from Finnish clubs, the judges' fees and expenses will be allocated to the participants as is customary in Finland. The entry fees and judges' fees and expenses will be invoiced after the competition.

Schedule: *The competition will take place between 9:00 and 21:00 on Saturday and 8:30 and 20:00 on Sunday.*

Cancellations:

After January 10, only cancellations verified by a medical certificate will be refunded. The medical certificate needs to be sent to the Organizer no later than February 20, 2010.

Awarding: *Three first standings of each category/class will be awarded. All participants will receive a diploma.*

Protocol/list of results:

The Protocol/list of results in each category will be published on the website. The Organizer will not provide print outs or CD´s.

The judges' scores of each skater will be uploaded to the competition web site right after the awarding ceremony, instead of providing print outs.

Judges:

The Organizer will invite the judges and other officials and pay their expenses. Composition and manning of the panel of judges, technical panel and other officials is determined and appointed by the Organizer. The names of the judges and the technical panel will be published on the website.

Expenses: *The Organizer will not pay any expenses for the participants.*

Protests: *Protest must be submitted to the Referee of the category at the latest immediately after the category. The protest fee is 15€. The Referee's decision is final.*

Liability: *According to the ISU Regulations, Rule 119, the Organizer accepts no liability for Injuries or damage sustained by competitors or officials. Participants are expected to provide their own insurances. The insurance should assure full medical attendance and also the return to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means of the ill or injured person.*

First aid: *Qualified first aid personnel will be present during the competition.*

Other information:

All updates to the competition schedule, and other information about the competition, will be published on the website, which we recommend to check frequently.
