## Confirmation of the International Figure Skating Competition

*The Figure Skating Club Tikkurilan Taitoluisteluklubi ry, Vantaa, Finland is pleased to confirm your skaters' participation in Tikkurila Trophy, an international figure skating competition.*

**Time:** October 27-28, 2018

**Venue:** Tikkurila Trio Areena ice rink

**The competition will be held in the following single skating categories and classes:**

Springs A younger (born after 30.10.2007), FS  
Springs A older (born 1.1.-30.10.2007), FS  
Springs B younger (born after 20.9.2008), FS  
Springs B older (born 1.1.2007-20.9.2008), FS  
Novice B Girls (born 1.7.2003 or later), FS  
Junior B Girls (born 1.7.1999 - 30.6.2005), SP & FS

*Entries received in Springs' categories have been split in two equal size age categories as of October 6, 2018.*

*In all categories, the ISU judging will be applied.*

*Finnish rules will be followed in the competition. Teams from abroad are encouraged to contact the Organizer for more information.*

# Tikkurila Trophy

**Skaters:** *The list of confirmed skaters has been posted on the competition website. If an accepted skater cannot compete, please inform the Organizer as soon as possible by e-mail ([kilpailut.ttk@gmail.com](mailto:kilpailut.ttk@gmail.com)).*

*In categories Novice B and Junior B some skaters have been placed on a waiting list. If/when there will be an opportunity to accept further skaters in these categories, the Organizer will contact respective clubs.*

*Until the draw, such a situation may occur if there are cancellations in any competition category. After the draw, until October 21, skaters on the waiting list will be offered an opportunity to compete only in case of cancellations in the same category they are on the waiting list for.*

**Planned program content:**

*The planned program content, if not submitted yet, should be sent by email to [kilpailut.ttk@gmail.com](mailto:kilpailut.ttk@gmail.com).*

**Music:** *Music of all competitors, if not sent yet, should be sent by e-mail to [kilpailut.ttk@gmail.com](mailto:kilpailut.ttk@gmail.com). The file should preferably be in mp3 format. Naming convention to be applied is Lastname\_Firstname\_SP or Lastname\_Firstname\_FS. We appreciate if the music files can be sent in a consolidated manner by the club, not separately by each individual skater.*

*CD's should also be brought to the ice rink upon arrival, but the Organizer's intention is to use them solely as a fall back plan. The music recordings should state the full name of the skater, category and the name of the club and country.*

**Schedule:** *The preliminary competition schedule can be found on the website. Please note that the schedule is likely still to be updated closer to the competition. Schedule updates, if any, will be provided after the draw, and a more detailed schedule will be published in connection with the confirmation of the warm-up groups.*

*Warm-up time will be four minutes for Springs' categories, five minutes for Novice B and Junior B SP. Warm-up time will be six minutes in Junior B FS. We will follow a flexible timetable throughout the competition.*

**Free skating:**

*Free skating programs in Junior B will be skated in the reverse order of the short program results. All skaters will be admitted to the free skating competition.*

**Practice:** *No practice ice will be arranged, as the competition will need all available ice time.*



# Tikkurila Trophy

**Draw:** *The draw will take place on October 15, 2018, and will be performed with the ISUCalc software. The result of the draw will be published on the website. The warm-up groups confirmed in the evening of October 24, 2018.*

**Entry fee:** **Entry fee/skater**

- Springs A 40 euro/skater
- Springs B 40 euro/skater
- Novice B 45 euro/skater
- Junior B 60 euro/skater

*In addition, the judges' fees and expenses will be allocated to the participants as is customary in Finland.*

**Cancellations:**

*After September 25, only cancellations verified by a medical certificate will be refunded. The medical certificate needs to be sent to the Organizer no later than October 31, 2018.*

*Skaters on the waiting list can be withdrawn without charges.*

**Awarding:** *Three first standings of each category/class will be awarded. All participants will receive a diploma.*

**Protocol/list of results:**

*The Protocol/list of results in each category will be published on the website. The Organizer will not provide print outs or CD's.*

*The judges' scores of each skater will be uploaded to the competition web site right after the awarding ceremony, instead of providing print outs.*

**Judges:** *The Organizer will invite the judges and other officials and pay their expenses. Composition and manning of the panel of judges, technical panel and other officials is determined and appointed by the Organizer. The names of the judges and the technical panel will be published on the website.*

**Expenses:** *The Organizer will not pay any expenses for the participants.*

**Protests:** *Protest must be submitted to the Referee of the category at the latest immediately after the category. The protest fee is 15€. The Referee's decision is final.*
