## Announcement of the International Figure Skating Competition

*The Figure Skating Club Tikkurilan Taitoluisteluklubi ry, Vantaa, Finland has the pleasure to invite skaters to participate in Tikkurila Winter Trophy, an international figure skating competition.*

*The Competition will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations, the ISU Special Regulations for Figure Skating as well as all pertinent ISU Communications for Figure Skating.*

**Categories:** *Basic Novice, girls*  
(skaters who have not reached the age of 13 before July 1 preceding the event) FS

*Intermediate Novice, girls*  
(skaters who have not reached the age of 15 before July 1 preceding the event) FS

*Advanced Novice, girls*  
(skaters who have reached the age of 10 but not 15 before July 1 preceding the event) SP & FS

*Junior ladies* SP & FS

*Basic Novice will be split in age groups, potentially also Intermediate Novice.*

*In all categories, the ISU judging will be applied. Further, ISU requirements and rules according to ISU Communication No. 2172 for Novice categories and ISU Reg 611 and 612 for Juniors or any subsequent updates will be applied.*

## **Entries:**

All clubs and members of the National Figure Skating Federations associated with the ISU, are invited to take part in the competition. Each club has the right to enter the desired number of competitors in any category. The Organizer reserves the right to limit the participants, in case the number of entries is too high. The clubs are asked to list the skaters in the order in which they wish to be accepted to the competition.

To participate, please fill in the attached entry form (Annex A) and send by email to [kilpailut.ttk@gmail.com](mailto:kilpailut.ttk@gmail.com).

**The Organizer will apply the first come first serve principle in confirming skaters from Finnish clubs as participants in the competition, from the day this announcement has been published.** This means that clubs can expect a confirmation within a few days after having sent their entry form.

In any case, all entries must be submitted by **Sunday January 6, 2019 at 16:00 EET**. Entries received after the deadline will not be accepted. Please note that the competition may become fully booked already in advance of January 6.

Please attach the planned program component sheet (Annex B).

The Organizer plans to be able to confirm all accepted skaters by January 27, 2019.

# Tikkurila Winter Trophy

**Participants from Finnish clubs**

- Basic Novice 40 euro/skater
- Intermediate Novice 45 euro/skater
- Advanced Novice 60 euro/skater
- Junior 60 euro/skater

*In addition, for participants from Finnish clubs, the judges' fees and expenses will be allocated to the participants as is customary in Finland. The entry fees and judges' fees and expenses will be invoiced after the competition.*

**Schedule:** *The competition will take place between 9:00 and 21:00 on Saturday and 8:00 and 20:00 on Sunday. More details will be provided in the competition confirmation.*

**Cancellations:**

*After January 10, only cancellations verified by a medical certificate will be refunded. The medical certificate needs to be sent to the Organizer no later than February 20, 2019.*

**Draw:** *The timing of the draw will be stated in the confirmation. The warm-up groups will be confirmed on February 14, 2019.*

**Practice:** *If ice time is available, practice will be arranged. This will be stated in the confirmation. Practice will only be organized for skaters, who have indicated on the entry form that they wish to participate. The fee for practice is 8€/skater/20 minutes. Competition music will not be played.*

**Awarding:** *Three first standings of each category/class will be awarded. All participants will receive a diploma.*

**Music:** *Please send program music of all competitors by e-mail to [kilpailut.ttk@gmail.com](mailto:kilpailut.ttk@gmail.com) by January 15. The file should preferably be in mp3 format. Naming convention to be applied is Lastname\_Firstname\_SP or Lastname\_Firstname\_FS. We appreciate if the music files can be sent in a consolidated manner by the club, not separately by each individual skater.*

*CD's should also be brought to the ice rink upon arrival, but the Organizer's intention is to use them solely as a fall back plan. The music recordings should state the full name of the skater, category and the name of the club, and country.*
