



Privacy Notice EBEN Europe

European Business Ethics Network (“we”, “us”, “our”) is a Dutch association. We respect your privacy and process your personal data in accordance with the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and applicable Dutch privacy law.

1) Who is responsible for your data?

2) What personal data do we process?

When you apply for membership and while you remain a member, we process the following personal data:

- Full name
- Date of birth
- Postal address
- Email address
- Institutional affiliation
- Title, position at institution
- Research and teaching interests

3) Why do we process your data (purposes)?

We process your personal data for these purposes only:

1. **Membership administration:** maintaining our membership register, communicating with you about your membership, convening the General Assembly and managing membership-related matters.
2. **Newsletter:** sending you our newsletter and updates about the association.

4) What is our legal basis for processing?

We process your personal data on the following GDPR legal bases:

- **Performance of a contract** (GDPR Article 6(1)(b)): to administer your membership (your membership application and membership relationship).
- **Legitimate interests** (GDPR Article 6(1)(f)): to keep members informed about the association's activities via the newsletter.
 - You can object to receiving the newsletter at any time (see section 8).

5) Where do we get your data from?

We receive your personal data directly from you (for example via a membership form, email, or other communication).

6) Who has access to your data? Do we share it?

- Your data is accessible only to authorized board members who need it for membership administration and sending the newsletter.
- **We do not sell your data and we do not share it with third parties**, except if we are legally required to do so.
- **We do not use algorithms for automated decision-making or profiling methods in respect of your data.**

7) International transfers

We do not intentionally transfer your personal data outside the European Economic Area (EEA).

8) How long do we keep your data?

We keep your data no longer than necessary:

- **Membership register:** for the duration of your membership. After your membership ends, we retain your data for **1 year** for administrative purposes, unless a longer retention is required by law.
- **Newsletter:** we keep your email address on the mailing list until you unsubscribe or object to receiving the newsletter.

9) Your rights under the GDPR

You have the following rights (subject to legal conditions):

- **Right of access** – to request a copy of your personal data
- **Right to rectification** – to correct inaccurate or incomplete data
- **Right to erasure** – to request deletion of your data
- **Right to restriction** – to request limitation of processing
- **Right to object** – in particular, to object to receiving the newsletter
- **Right to data portability** – for data you provided to us, in a structured, commonly used format (where applicable)

10) Withdrawal / unsubscribe from newsletter

If you no longer want to receive our newsletter, you can:

11) Complaints
