TAFISA

Who is TAFISA and what does TAFISA Patronage means?

<u>TAFISA</u> began in the **1960's** as the semi regular gathering of international but individual personalities and leaders interested and working in the field of Sport for All. In **1991**, TAFISA registered its statues with the law courts of Frankfurt, Germany and in 2005 became professional with offices in Frankfurt. In **2009**, TAFISA officially changed its name to 'The Association For International Sport for All' to more accurately describe its activities and its position as the leading international Sport for All association.

TAFISA is recognised by the International Olympic Committee, the World Health Organization, UNESCO and the International Council of Sport Science and Physical Education.

Due to high demand, TAFISA has developed Patronage Guidelines for events in the field of Sport for All and Physical Activity (SAPA). By providing Patronage it is TAFISA's goal to support it's members in good standing, who are providing the platform for men and women of various age groups and abilities to develop, compete in, demonstrate and/or participate in their particular sport or physical activity in the direction of SAPA.

IFAA has been a member of TAFISA since November 2011 and has since received TAFISA Patronage for all IFAA World Championships and regional tournaments.

Every two months TAFISA releases its e-Newsletter to provide members, friends and supporters with relevant and interesting information. The TAFISA e-Newsletter focuses both on internal TAFISA matters, as well as general issues in the field of Sport for All and physical activity. April 2016 Newsletter found here

The 2016 WFAC will be hosted by the Wagga Wagga Field Archers. The event will be a 5 day field format (Field/Hunter/Animal/Field/Hunter), beginning with the Opening Ceremony on Sunday, 25 September and the Closing Ceremony on Friday, 30 September at 7pm. Four ranges are being prepared and the Cubs and Juniors will shoot on the same ranges as the Adults and Veterans.
