## NOTICE: 2014 IFAA BOOK OF RULES CORRECTION

It has been brought to our attention that a section in the 2014 Book of Rules has omitted wording which needs to be corrected.

The correction pertains to the By-Laws, page 37, Article IV, Sub Article H 2c.

Article to read:

c. **Except where otherwise stated each archer shall shoot from the same side,** however on targets 1 and 15 the archers shall change their order of shooting: Those who shot first shall shoot last and those who shot last shall shoot first. Those archers who had been shooting from the right side shall shoot from the left side and those who had been shooting from the left side shall shoot from the right side.

**An archer may opt, with the consent of the Target Captain, to shoot from the opposite side if he considers himself to be at a disadvantage from his own side at a particular target.**

The wording in red was omitted by accident.

Kindly amend your own records and inform your members accordingly. An updated version of the 2014 BOR will be available for download on the IFAA web page soon.
