Entries Each invited club has the right to enter competitors in any category and class.

Entry fee Categories with Finnish Star-evaluation 40 €
Categories with ISU evaluation, one day 55 €
Categories with ISU evaluation, two days 80 €

Awarding Three first standings of each category/class will be awarded with a small cup

and a diploma.

Protests Protest must be submitted to the Referee of the relevant event at the latest

immediately after the event. Upon the submission of the protest a protest fee of 15

EUR must be paid. The referee's decision is final.

Travel expenses, board and accommodation will be paid by the participants. Expenses related to the competition's judges and technical management will be covered by the entry fees and by TTK.

Deadline for the entries is the 1st of September 2010 at latest.

Entries received after the deadline will not be accepted.

The entries for each category should be in the club's order of preference in the case of need to limit the number of entries. The organizer reserves the right to enter more competitors.

Entry fee payment

All entry fees of one club have to be paid with one bank transaction to the organizer's given bank account on the 6th of September. The entry fee payment details will be sent in the confirmation email.

Cancellations

After the 6th of September 2010 only cancellations verified by a medical certificate will be refunded. However, in all cases of cancellations after the 6th of September, a fee of 15 € to cover organizer's office costs has to be paid.

RECOMMENDATIONS

A-CLASS

<u>CUBS Girls, born 2001 or later</u> Free skating: max 2 min 30 sec Finnish Star-evaluation

- 1. All single jumps. One which may be Axel type jump and/or not more than 1 double jump.
- 2. 3 spins which should have min 4 revolutions.
- 3. 1 step sequence covering ½ of the ice.
- 4. 2 unsupported spirals

SPRINGS A Girls

Free skating: max 2 min 40 sec ISU evaluation

- Maximum of 5 jump elements. One must be Axel type jump.
 There shall be at least 3 different type double jumps which may be repeated once either in a jump combination or in a jump sequence. Not more than 2 jump combinations or sequences.
 Only 1 jump combination may contain 3 jumps.
- 2. Three different spins of a different nature. One which must be a spin combination (min 8 revolutions) with or without a change of foot. One must be a spin in one foot and in one position (min 5 rev) and may start with a jump. One different spin which is either one foot and one position spin (min 5 rev) or a spin combination (min 8 rev).
- 3. One step sequence.
- 4. Minimum of 2 unsupported spirals (evaluated in transitions)

NB: In Springs, falling deduction is -0.5 points/falling.

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B-CLASS

SPRINGS B Girls and Boys Free skating: max 2 min 40 sec Finnish Star-evaluation

- Maximum of 5 jump elements. One must be Axel type jump.
 There shall be at least 1 double jump. Double jumps may be repeated once either in a jump combination or in a jump sequence. Not more than 2 jump combinations or sequences. Only 1 jump combination may contain 3 jumps.
- 2. Three different spins of a different nature. One which must be a spin combination (min 8 revolutions) with or without a change of foot.

 One must be a spin in one foot and in one position (min 5 rev) and may start with a jump. One different spin which is either a one foot and one position spin (min 5 rev) or a spin combination (min 8 rev)
- 3. One step sequence.
- 4. Minimum of 2 unsupported spirals.

NOVICE B Girls, born 1996 or later Free skating: 3.00 min (+/- 10sec) ISU-evaluation

- 1.Maximum of 6 jump elements. One must be Axel type jump. There shall be at least three different double jumps. There must be at least one jump combination and maximum of three jump combinations or sequences. Only one jump combination may contain three jumps. Double and triple jumps may be repeated once either in a jump combination or in a jump sequence.
- 2. Three different spins of a different nature. One which must be a spin combination with or without a change of foot (min 8 revolutions). One which must be a spin in one foot and in one position (min 5 rev) and may start with a jump. One different spin which is either a one foot and one position spin (min 5 rev) or a spin combination (min 8 rev).
- 3. Spiral sequence. In a spiral sequence, there must be at least two spirals (min 3 sec each) or one spiral (min 6 sec).

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JUNIOR B Girls, born 1.7.1991-30.6.1997

<u>SENIOR B Ladies, born 30.6.1995 or before</u>

Short program: max 2 min 50 sec, Free skating: max 3 min 40 sec ISU-evaluation

Short program 7 elements:

- 1. Axel or double axel.
- 2. Double jump preceded by steps or other free skating movements.
- 3. Jump combination (double-double), jumps must be different than a solo jump.
- 4. Flying spin (min 6 revolutions).
- 5. Layback spin (min 6 rev in position).
- 6. Spin combination with 3 basic positions and only one change of foot (min 5+5 rev).
- 7. Step sequence.

Free skating 11 elements:

- Maximum of 7 jump elements. One must be Axel type jump. There must be at least one jump combination or jump sequence and maximum of 3 jump combinations or sequences. Two different kinds of triple or quadruple jumps may be repeated twice either in a jump combination or in a jump sequence.
- 2. Three different spins of a different nature. One which must be a spin combination (min 10 revolutions) with or without a change of foot. One must be a spin in one foot and in one position (min 5 rev) and may start with a jump. One different spin which may be either a spin in one position and in one foot (min 5 rev) or a spin combination (min 10 rev).
- 3. Step sequence.
