| Deductible for private medical expenses insurance | 70% | Max. 400 e/y | If the cost would have been reimbursable according to the rules of the health insurance |

1) As of 1.1.2023, the ceiling amount for dental care reimbursements combined: 70% of all dental care is reimbursed, up to a maximum of EUR 400 per year. All dental care reimbursements also have a one-year term!

2) Public health care fees incl. e.g. treatment day, outpatient care, day sickness, serial care, health centre fees, X-ray examinations in oral health care and examinations performed with a referral from a private doctor.

3) Medicines (not sv-remb.) and injections given by a doctor **are not** reimbursed for contraception, vaccination, trace elements, minerals, nutritional, herbal, vitamin, tobacco withdrawal, erectile dysfunction and diet pills.

4) Studies incl. e.g. laboratory, magnetic, radiological, ultrasound, neural pathway, sleep apnea, ECG examinations. Examinations are reimbursed up to a maximum of EUR 800 per year

Benefits are paid up to a maximum of EUR 4,000 per calendar year per insured person. Medical expenses are not included in the above-mentioned amount.

Treatment provided abroad is not reimbursed. Application period six (6) months.
