About the Grant

- **Number of grants:** 2
- **Grant amount:** €10,000 per grant
- **Application period:** May 18 - August 14, 2026
- **Target group:** Researchers based in Finland, at an early or established stage of their career, with projects related to inborn metabolic diseases.

Evaluation Criteria

Applications will be evaluated based on:

- Scientific quality and originality
- Relevance to the field of rare metabolic diseases
- Feasibility and project plan
- Potential clinical or societal impact

All applications will be reviewed by an independent scientific committee with expertise in metabolic diseases and rare disorders.

Application Requirements

Applications must include:

- Short CV and publication list
- Letter of support from supervisor (for PhD students) or head of department (for others)
