It is with great pleasure that the archery club Arcus, in collaboration with Archery Denmark and World Archery Nordic, invites you to NUM 2024. Odense Athletics Stadium will be the setting for a fantastic championship from Thursday, July 4th to Sunday, July 7th.

Shooting

Competition will be held in all bow types and age categories according to the WA Nordic rules. Additionally, each class is divided between boys and girls.

The youngest allowed age is archers born in 2011.

The oldest allowed age is archers born in 2004.

All archers must bring identification such as a passport with documentation of their birthdate and year.

RU21 Open is a special NUM class. All archers in Olympic Recurve who are not comfortable shooting the long distances can participate in the RU21 Open class. This class is open to all archers, ranging from 13 years old to 20 years old, but it is likely most relevant for the U18 and U21 age groups.

Finals and medal ceremonies will be held in this class like the other classes.

Only accredited archers and coaches have access to the shooting range itself. Parents and spectators are directed to the stands behind the shooting line. The stands are covered and can accommodate up to 8.000 spectators. From all seats in the stands, there is a good view of the entire shooting range.

Each nation is allocated one coach accreditation for every 3 archers they have registered. Coaches are encouraged to wear their nation's T-shirt

Food and drinks

The rooms will be allocated according to preferences as much as possible, but in case of overbooking, we may need to assign different rooms than those requested.

Deadlines, registration, and tournament fees

The regular registration deadline is Wednesday, May 15th. Foreign archers register on a national basis at <u>tilmelding@arcus.dk</u>.

Registration is only valid once the registration fee has been received. Registration is binding.

For regular registration, no later than Wednesday, May 15th, the following prices apply.

Tournament fee EUR 150. Includes participation in the tournament and the banquet on Saturday evening.

We aim to publish a participant list as soon as possible afterward on lanseo.

The final registration deadline is Friday, May 24th, and thereafter, no late registrations will be possible.

For registrations between May 15th and May 24th, there will be an additional fee of 60 Euros per archer.

How to arrive

By private plane to H.C. Andersen Airport: We arrange pick-up at the airport, which is located 20 minutes from the stadium. Contact us for more information.

By flying to Kastrup (CPH):

Head down to the train station in the basement of Terminal 3 at the airport and take the train to Odense. From Odense train station, the light rail departs from the station (heading towards Tarup) and goes directly to the Stadium.

The Odense light rail and city buses use the same ticketing system. Train tickets are valid (except for orange tickets). Additionally, at all stops, it's possible to purchase a ticket by scanning a QR code. The ticket is valid for 1 hour and 15 minutes. The price is 15 kr for adults and 10 kr for youths under 26 years old. Upon arrival for foreign archers, we will have a person to pick up nation groups at Odense train station.

By train:

From Odense train station, the light rail departs from the station (heading towards Tarup) and goes directly to the Stadium.

By long-distance bus:

From Parking South, the light rail departs (heading towards Tarup) and goes directly to the Stadium.

By car:

Parking options are available at Stadionvej 25, 5200 Odense V, and there are also parking options on the west side of the stadium, Møllemarksvej 71, 5200 Odense V.
