

The Embassy of Spain in collaboration with the University of the Arts Helsinki (Uniarts Helsinki), the Baltic Marine Environment Protection Commission (HELCOM), and Oceanographies Collective, is organizing the event **A Healthy Baltic Sea: A Living Matrix**, on **1 September 2026, from 14:00 to 16:30, at the Myllytori exhibition space of the University of the Arts Helsinki** (Sörnäisten rantatie 19).

The event will bring together scientists, experts, artists, and researchers to reflect on the Baltic Sea as a living matrix of interdependencies, where natural and human processes are deeply interconnected. Its purpose is to promote understanding of these challenges, as well as the protection and environmental stewardship of the Baltic Sea, through dialogue between science, art, and society.

Visual artist **Inma Herrera** will present an artistic intervention inspired by the concepts of matrix, memory, and imprint, fostering a dialogue between science, art, and ecology while encouraging collective reflection on the care and sustainability of the Baltic Sea.

The event will conclude with a Spanish wine reception, offering an opportunity for further discussion and exchange.
