General Regulations:

The Juna Skate Open 10th competition will be held for young and beginner skaters single skaters, solo ice dance and ice dance. The competition will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2024 and all respective ISU Communications for figure skating and the technical requirements of the Estonian Skating Union for the season 2025/2026. The results will be calculated according to ISU judges system.

Participation in the Juna Skate Open 10th is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member, and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 a) and they meet the participation requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication.

The results will be calculated according to ISU judges system.

Registration of entries for Juna Skate Open 10th

All ISU-Members and all Clubs, National Figure Skating Federations associated with ISU are invited to the competition in any category and class. However, the Organizer shall have the right to limit the number of skaters from the invited clubs, and split categories if the number of participants requires that.

By registering for the Juna Skate Open 10th competition, the club confirms that it has the consent of the parents of minor athletes and the consent of adult athletes for the performance, audio and video recording of the performance, and publication of the athlete's performance.

The club is responsible that each athlete participating in the competition has legal music used during the performance.

The deadline for entries is **16. March 2026**. All entries to the Juna Skate Open 10th must be submitted using the **Sportity Online Registration system**: <https://fs.sportity.com/> .

The clubs, that don't have an account should contact Sportity by email: info@sportity.com and inquire about registration by providing the following information: Name of Organization, Reg.code, Country, contact e-mail address. Please provide your contact information (e-mail, phone) on the entry form skater's profile. In case of late entry for competition plus 10 EUR will be added to the entry fee.

Entry fee*:

Single/Solo skaters with one program/event — 90€ per person

Single/Solo skaters with two programs/events — 110€ per person
(two patterns/rhythm/short program+free skating)

Ice dance/Pair with one program — 130€ per couple

Ice dance/Pair with two programs — 150€ per couple (two patterns/rhythm+free skating)

Elements - 60€ per person

* Entry fee includes an entrance fee 5 euros per person and their accompanying persons/team.

Deadline for payment is **1. April 2026**.

Payment can be made 100% to a bank account . Club can change one skater to another in the same category 24 hours before the drawing. The entry fee will not be refunded in case of withdrawals for any reason, except when the Organizer has to reduce the entries. Payment must be made to:

In order for your registration to be approved in SpORITY, please submit music for the program(s) by **April 10th 2026:**

Each application must be properly labeled with the ISU member's name, category name, segment name, and the name(s) of the participant(s).

Music files must be submitted in WAV or MP3 format. Any other formats are not accepted. Please note: MP3 files may vary significantly in playback quality. In this case, the Organizing Committee is not responsible for any unsatisfactory music quality. Each Participant must have their own backup drive (USB stick) for each program in WAV or MP3 file format.

**Protests:**

Each team has the right to submit protest against the judge's decision. Protests must be submitted to the Referee of the relevant event at the latest immediately after the event. Upon the submission of the protest a protest fee of 50 EUR must be paid. The referee's decision is final. In the new ISU Judging Systems no protests can be filed against the judges (see Rule 123), but against the right determination of the executed element or any calculation error. In the ISU Judging System protest can be submitted in 24 hours after subsegment (e.g. Short Program) and before the awarding ceremony after the final segment (e.g. Free Skating). Protest must be done in a written form to the referee of the relevant segment. Please read ISU Rule 123.
