World Taekwondo Official Competition Rules and Guidelines.

Explanation: WT competition rules as implemented in Finland. For further information regarding the competition rules, please contact the referee director of the competition.

Daedo PSS will be used at this Tournament and will be provided by the Organizing Committee. Video replay will be used in Cadet, Junior and Senior categories. All athletes must bring their own Daedo sensor socks. Head gears, groin/forearm/shin guards and gloves are compulsory and must be brought by the contestants. Mouth piece is compulsory (only white or transparent)!

- * The center referee makes the decision if the impact in a kick to head is too strong (KO) in the Cadet categories.
- ** Head contact optional = The center referee asks before each match if the athletes wishes to allow head contact. If both athletes and coaches agree, the head contact is allowed. If one or more of the players or coaches refuses, head contact is prohibited.

Kids (under 13 years old) can participate both in the kids' and beginners' categories. Competitors competing in the official categories cannot compete in the kids' or beginners' categories.

In the beginners' pair and team categories the players can be of the same or of different gender. If the players in a pair are of different belt grade groups, they compete in the pairs, higher belts category.

In case there is a low number of competitors in the kids' or beginners' categories, the organizers may combine categories if permitted by the referee director. If two categories are combined, the players will perform poomsae according to the category they were originally registered to.

Rules: The WT Poomsae rules (as of May, 2019) will be used except as noted below.

- A competitor participating in any official category cannot participate in kids' or beginners' categories
- The compulsory poomsae for the official categories will be drawn and published on the competition's website on Friday the 8th of May before 8 pm. The poomsae lists are as described in Article 8 of the WT Poomsae rules, except for the following: in individual over 40 the WT list for individual under 60 will be used, and in the pairs and teams under 17 the WT lists for junior pairs and junior teams, respectively, will be used.
- In the official categories, only a final round will be held if there are eight (8) or fewer competitors. If there are nine (9) or more competitors, a semi-final round will be held, and the eight (8) players with the highest score will advance to the final round. In the final round, two (2) drawn poomsae will be performed. In the semi-final round, only one (1) poomsae will be performed.
- In the kids' and beginners' categories only the final round will be held regardless
 of the number of competitors. Each competitor will perform two poomsae. The
 poomsae are free of choice from the poomsae list of the category, except that
 the same poomsae cannot be performed twice by the player. In kids' categories
 the player is allowed to perform the same poomsae twice if it's the lowest
 poomsae on the list.
- Prizes: one (1) gold medal for the first place, one (1) silver medal for the second

place, and one (1) bronze medal for the third place. No medal will be awarded for the fourth place.
