QUALIFICATION:

The athletes must represent their own club. All the Finnish athletes have to be holders of The Finnish Taekwondo Federation License. All the Finnish athletes who will participate the advanced categories need to have their Athlete Agreement signed and returned to Finnish Taekwondo Federation. Kids under 18-years must have approval from their guardian to participate the contest. Participants in beginners' categories have to be at least holders of 8th kup belt and participants in advanced categories (cadets, juniors and seniors) must be at least holders of 6th kup belt.

Club coaches are responsible to add their competitors in categories of the correct level. Competition Jury has a right to cancel player's participation in beginners' categories if the player is participated in wrong level category considering players age, level of skill, experience and the safety of other competitors in the same category. Jury's decision is final and entry fees will not be returned.

EQUIPMENT AND VIDEO REPLAY:

Daedo PSS will be used at this Tournament and will be provided by the Organizing Committee. Video replay will be used in Cadet, Junior and Senior categories. All athletes must bring their own Daedo sensor socks. Head gears, groin/forearm/shin guards and gloves are compulsory and must be brought by the contestants. Mouth piece is compulsory (only white or transparent).

* The center referee makes the decision if the impact in a kick to head is too strong (KO) in the Cadet categories.

** Head contact optional = The center referee asks before each match if the athletes wishes to allow head contact. If both athletes and coaches agree, the head contact is allowed. If one or more of the players or coaches refuses, head contact is prohibited.

It is the responsibility of each club to ensure that sufficient insurance coverage has been taken out for all officials and participants.

All the Finnish coaches have to be holders of The Finnish Taekwondo Federation License and need to have their Official Agreement signed and returned to Finnish Taekwondo Federation.
