The payments for accommodation and entry fee should be made in cash at registration in “**Dzingel**” hotel (Männiku str. 89, Tallinn).

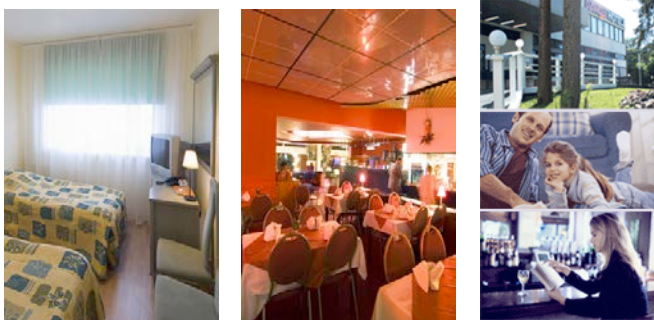
You should send all team members photos for making ID cards to the Organizing Committee, as soon as possible and not later than 12th of January 2014 by e-mail games@tkd.ee

Information about Taekwondo competitions:

Organizer: Estonian Martial Arts Union

Promoter: Estonian Taekwondo Union

Registration: Registration will be start on 31.01.2014 from 12.00 to 19.00 in “Dzingel” hotel (Männiku str. 89, Tallinn). The payments for accommodation and entry fee should be made in cash at registration in “Dzingel” hotel (Männiku str. 89, Tallinn).

Discipline championship: individual Sparring

Sparring (kyrugi): Individual competition, according to the rules of taekwondo WTF 2008 (amended 2010), in electronic protectors «Dae Do», as supplemented and amended by this provision. Places: 1- 1st place; 1- 2nd place; 1- 3rd place

Qualification of participants:

B Division: 1 year training or to a green belt (6 kup).

A-Division: over 1 year of practice or above the green belt (6 kup)

Weight categories:

Children after 2005 : Please put a real sportsmen weight, and we make a categories

Children (2005-2001)

Boys : -22, -24,-27,-31,-35,-39, -44, +44

Girls.: -22, -24, -27, -31, -35, +35

Cadets (12- 14)

Boys: -33,-37,-41,-45,-49,-53,-57,+57

Girls: -33,-37,-41,-45,-49,-53,+53

Juniors (15- 18)

Boys: -48, -55, -63, -73,+73

Girls: -44, -49, -55, -63,+63

Seniors (+18)

Men: -58, -68, -80, +80

Women: -49, -57, -67, +67

(If there are less than 4 participants in a category, categories may be combined.)

Entry fee for individual participation: €20 entry fee per participant, which must be paid during registration.

Equipment for sparring: mandatory equipment: helmet, protector, mouthpiece, groin-protector, the soft protectors on the lower leg and foot, and forearm, as well as sensory socks «Dae Do». Electronic chest protectors «Dae Do» will be provided by the organizers of the tournament, the remaining equipment should be personalized for each athlete. **In the absence of sensory socks, they can be bought on the spot of the competition.**

Awards ceremony: The winners will be awarded medals and diplomas. Top athletes of the competition will be awarded prizes and cups.

Team competitions 5x5:

B Division: 1 year training or to a green belt (6 kup).

A-Division: over 1 year of practice or above the green belt (6 kup)

“A” and “B” divisions are separate.

Categories: Cadets (2000-1998)
Juniors(1997- 1995)
Seniors(1994-)

Teams: Five competitors in each team. Competitors weight difference must be minimum 3kg.

Fights: Fights will be five rounds by 1 min (5x1min)

All points will be summarized

Team without 1 competitor give -5 points

Knockout give +5 points

Winner is the team who have more points

Equipment for sparring: mandatory equipment: helmet, protector, mouthpiece, groin-protector, the soft protectors on the lower leg and foot, and forearm, as well as sensory socks «Dae Do». Electronic chest protectors «Dae Do» will be provided by the organizers of the tournament, the remaining equipment should be personalized for each athlete.

Entry fee: 30€ per team.

Awarding: All entry fees go to the „fund“. Winner get this „fund“.

Protest: A protest (written statement addressed to the organizers of the event and video battle) may be filed only by the representative of a team within 5 minutes after the match. The protest must be filed with a deposit - 100 euros. In meeting the protest, the deposit is returned. If the protest is rejected, the deposit is not refundable.

Representative (VIP):

The Organizing Committee will provide free Hotel accommodation (31.01.-02.02.2014) for one (1) representative and one (1) umpire per organization (if delegation contains not less than 15 persons) and staying in the hotel “Dzingel”.

Coaches: Only one person is permitted to accompany the athlete to the match site. He or she should be dressed in sportswear and sports shoes, and must participate in the meeting.

Referees: Each team can provide two referees. Uniform of the referees: black (dark) pants, white shirt and sport shoes. The referees will be paid for their work.

State Symbols: We request all teams carry a flag of their country in the size of 90 cm x 130 cm. Please present the flag to the organizers at the time of the competition.

Insurance and medical admission: All athletes must be healthy and have no restrictions on participation in the competition. Application for these events must also be signed by the representative of the team. Insurance is offered to the athletes by a coach or the team representative. The representative of the team is responsible for the team and takes full responsibility for the accuracy and authenticity of the credentials and documents on the athletes participating provided to the organizing committee.

Injuries: All competitors take part in competitions at their own risk. For injuries received during the contest organizers are not liable. Athletes will be provided with necessary medical first aid.
