QUALIFICATION AND LIABILITY

Competitors must represent their own club. The club representative who registers competitors is responsible for ensuring that the competitors have adequate insurance coverage. Competitors under the age of 18 must have parental consent to participate. Club representatives are responsible for registering their competitors in the correct categories. The referee director has a right to cancel a competitor's participation, if the competitor is not in the correct category considering the competitor's age and skill level.

Competitors can participate in two competition categories (age and weight categories). Competitors may apply for an exemption to participate in an age category one higher than their own by sending an application to the competition director, who will forward it to the kyorugi committee.

RULES

Competition system: Single elimination tournament and best of 3 system.

Daedo GEN3 system is used in the advanced league categories. **Only** GEN3 electronic socks are permitted. GEN3 electronic socks can be borrowed from the organizer, please contact the competition director no later than Sunday 23.8.2026 (maika.gt@gmail.com). Daedo GEN2 system is used for the beginner categories. Both Daedo GEN2 and GEN3 electronic socks are permitted.

In beginner categories, the two-point gam-jeom penalty is not used during the final ten seconds of a round, as the GEN2 system does not support this function. In league categories, standard WT rules

are followed, and the two-point gam-jeom is in effect.

There will be bronze matches in all categories, but the competition organizer has the right to exclude bronze matches from the beginner categories due to scheduling issues.

Only semi contact to the head is allowed for pre-cadets (D1) and cadets (C1). For youth beginners (B2) and adult beginners (H, S), head contact is optional.

Coaches must be at least 15 years old. An underage coach must be accompanied by an adult coach. An adult coach is responsible for the safety of the competitor but may not coach the competitor. However, an adult coach may instruct an underage or adult coach in a teaching situation if they have permission from the referee director. Teaching does not include coaching the competitor. Permission must be requested in writing from the referee director before the competition. Permission is only valid for one competition at a time.

WEIGH-IN

Finnish clubs can apply for remote weigh-in rights from the referee director by email no later than Sunday 23.8.2026 (ville.montonen@taekwondovihti.fi). The application must be made in accordance with the remote weigh-in instructions. [etäpunnitushje 6.3.2025.pdf](#)

Competitors must prove their identity at the weigh-in with an official ID (driver's license, passport or ID card).

During the weigh-in, male competitors must wear underwear and female competitors must wear underwear and bra. However, the weigh-in can be done nude if the competitor in adult category so wishes. Competitors in underage categories must be weighed with underwear(s) and 100 grams will be allowed to compensate. Competitors must follow the weigh-in rules of the category in which they are participating.

If a competitor competes in two weight classes, they will only be weighed in the lower weight class. Once the lower weight class is accepted, the higher weight class will also be accepted at the same time.

Random weigh-in shall be conducted with plus 5 % tolerance of the contestant's weight category. The lower limit of the weight class is not considered in the random weigh-in.
