1. Name: WTF-Kyung Hee University Partnership Taekwondo Training Program

2. Kinds of courses and the duration:

***Each course might be cancelled , if the number of applicant is less than 10.**

1) Course for Sparring coaches in the 1st half:

- a) Dates: May. 3(Mon) - May. 28, 2010 (Fri) (4 weeks)
- b) No of participants: 20 / coaches only
- c) National quota: one per country in principle
- d) Age limit: 25 years old or older in principle
- e) Application deadline: Apr. 12, 2009

2) Course for Sparring athletes in the 1st half:

- a) Dates: June. 28(Mon) – July. 23, 2010 (Fri) (4 weeks)
- b) No of participants: 20 / athletes only
- c) National quota: one per country in principle
- d) Age limit: 20 years old or under in principle
- e) Application deadline: June. 07, 2009

3) Course for Poomsae and demonstration coaches in the 2nd half:

- f) Dates: Oct. 04 (Mon) – Oct. 30, 2010 (Sat) (4 weeks)
- g) No of participants: 20 / coaches only
- h) National quota: one per country in principle
- i) Age limit: 20 years old or under in principle 25 years old or older in principle
- j) Application deadline: Sep. 13, 2010

4) Course for Poomsae and demonstration athletes in the 2nd half:

- f) Dates: Nov. 22 (Wed) – Dec. 18, 2010 (Sat) (4 weeks)
- g) No of participants: 20 / athletes only
- h) National quota: one per country in principle
- i) Age limit: 20 years old or under in principle 25

j) Application deadline: Nov. 01, 2010

2. Place of education & accommodation: Kyung Hee University
(Suwon Campus in Gyeonggi Province)

3. Conditions:

- a) Roundtrip airfares: To be paid by the participant or pertinent National Association. However, airfares may be reimbursed by the WTF to the national association through the deduction from the WTF Reform Fund, subject to prior approval by the WTF.
- b) Tuition fee/room & board: To be jointly supported by the WTF and KHU
- c) Arrival in Korea: One or two days before the start of the program
- d) Insurance: Participants are required to be insured before their arrival in Korea.
- e) Duration of stay: Participants are required to shift out of their accommodation from Kyung Hee University no later than two (2) days after the completion of the course.
- f) Daily allowance: Member National Associations should ensure that their participants have adequate daily allowances during the period of the course. The WTF or Kyung Hee University will not be responsible for any other expenses than tuition fees and room & board.

4. Content of education: Taekwondo techniques, Poomsae, Comparative combination kicks, Comparative combinations kicks with focus pads, Sparring techniques, sports massage, competition with protector, acupuncture, Korean language, etc.

★ In the 1st half of the course , Sparring will be more intensively trained than Poomsae. Accordingly, in the 2nd half of the course , Poomsae and demonstration will be concentrated .

5. Local transportation: Cost of local transportation between Incheon Airport and Suwon should be paid by participants, who will be picked up at a place in Suwon designated by KHU. Details will be provided when WTF sends its acceptance of application.

6 Certification: Graduation certificates jointly signed by the presidents of the WTF and

Kyung Hee University will be awarded to participants who successfully complete their courses at the end of the program.

** Note: Participants who do not meet the standards for the course will not be awarded the certificates.*

7 Documents for application:

- a) Application form signed by the president of the pertinent Member National Association
- b) Curriculum vitae and photo of the applicant
- c) Recommendation letter signed by the president of the pertinent Member National Association
- d) Copy of Kukkiwon Dan certificate
- e) Copy of insurance policy in the name of the applicant
