Introduction to Espoon Biljardikerho and Club Activities:

EBK's activities consist of two distinct parts: Club Activities and Association Activities Association Activities:

- Espoon Biljardikerho ry. (est. 1980) is a member of the Finnish Billiard Federation (SBIL), and EBK members can participate in SBIL's billiard tournaments (Ranking and Finnish Championships) across Finland.
- EBK members play in the annual Espoon Biljardikerho championships in various disciplines, and only EBK members have the right to participate.
- You can join Espoon Biljardikerho by filling out the membership application form and paying the joining fee of 50 euros + annual fee of 50 euros.
- Final approval of membership must be obtained from the EBK board, and the application must be supported by a completed profile questionnaire (either on paper or through the website). Preferably, a photo should be included.
- EBK membership does not grant playing rights at the EBK club premises; members have a guest fee obligation at the club.

Club Activities:

- EBK's club (est. 2011) is a private club, and its members can be representatives of any member association or individuals who do not belong to any SBIL member association.
- Club members have unlimited playing and usage rights at the club but must adhere to the club's rules and principles. Playing at night is not recommended.
- Club members have their own annual tournaments, which only club members can participate in.
- Only individuals aged 18 and over can join the club activities, as minors cannot be alone in the club premises without special permission. However, minors can visit the club accompanied by a parent/guardian.
- A new applicant must fill out a membership application (either on paper or through the website) and provide a photo (e.g., via email). Additionally, the new applicant must familiarize themselves with the club's activities and various individuals by visiting the club 3-4 times (e.g., during weekly competitions or by other arrangements). Once the profile questionnaire is completed and the new applicant is somewhat familiar to the club members/EBK, the EBK board can then consider the approval of the new member. The membership approval process is facilitated/expedited if the new applicant is already known to an existing club member.
- After final approval of membership, club membership becomes effective once the guarantee fee + the current month's fee of 360 euros is paid, and the club agreement is signed. (The agreement is signed after the payments, and at the same time, the new club member receives their own access key to the club premises).
