This is only the beginning!

We have many more workcamps to be announced, they're just not ready yet. Indeed, with the municipal elections taking place this year in France, our programmation calendar has been disturbed. But be reassured, the following program shows less than half of what is to come, so there will be plenty of spots to be filled by your motivated volunteers!

New policy for ESC volunteers

This year, in order to reduce the number of ESC volunteers' cancellations, we will be collecting travel tickets in the Confirmation Form (they usually fill it when they receive the Infosheet).

Teen volunteers: fees and documents

For each Teen Volunteer (15-17 years old), the participation fee is still 250€, to be paid to Concordia, by bank transfer. If the fee is not to be paid in advance but on the spot, please send us a reminder!

Also to be done in advance: the filling (and sharing) of the Parental Agreement and the Medical Fact Sheet. For the second document, we'll need vaccination proof signed by the doctor (and not just a listing). This is mandatory!

No more reservations

In 2026, we will not be taking reservations from our partners. Indeed, reservations have caused us more issues than advantages for the past few years and we think it's best to move from this system and find more efficient ways of managing applications.

THE CHILDREN'S TREE: A SPACE TO LEARN

PROJET & WORK

The "Arbre aux Enfants" site is a place for learning about the environment and sustainable development, welcoming children, schools, and associations.

To enhance their outdoor spaces and give their summer an intercultural boost, the activities team is offering young international volunteers the chance to learn carpentry and woodworking techniques to build a wooden terrace and furniture! Other tasks may also be available, such as planting and maintaining green spaces to enhance the site.

ACCOMMODATION & MEALS

You will be staying at "Le Chanset" campsite in Ceyrat, in the Auvergne Volcanoes Regional Nature Park, near the Chaîne des Puys, in individual tents with inflatable mattresses and a communal large tent for group activities (tents are provided by Concordia). You will share various group tasks and prepare meals together. A budget will be allocated to the leaders and you will help with the shopping, focusing on healthy, local products. Free WiFi is available at the campsite. Laundry can be done by hand or in the washing machines at the campsite (paid service).



LOCATION & LEISURE ACTIVITIES

Clermont-Ferrand is the lively capital of the Auvergne region. It is located in an exceptional volcanic area, at the foot of the Puy de Dôme volcano and the Chaîne des Puys which is listed as UNESCO World Heritage. During your stay, you will be able to enjoy the town's summery energy (shows, concerts, fireworks, etc.) and the countryside which is located right on its doorstep: hiking over the volcanoes, swimming in the lakes, etc.

PARTNER

Concordia has been organizing international work camps with the city of Clermont-Ferrand since 1993! The city develops participatory projects with residents. Every year, we are present in lively neighborhoods, where residents create shared gardens and local associations organize activities.

This work camp invites you to participate in the life of "L'Arbre aux Enfants" site by helping to build an outdoor space made entirely of wood.

Local young people will be able to participate in the work camp alongside you and help you discover their area.

TO KNOW

The accommodation is located outside of the city of Clermont-Ferrand, in a little town in the countryside. Bring work clothes, walking boots, a backpack and a swimming suit. Nights can be chilly, so bring warm clothes and a good sleeping bag. You can also bring recipes from your home country, musical instruments and games.

MOUNTAIN MAKERS FOR A GREENER TOMORROW

Valloire (73)

PROJET & WORK

Join a committed project in Valloire, one of the most beautiful places in Savoie!

Your mission ? Contribute to improving the living environment by building steps on a hiking trail. Supervised by professionals, you will discover environmentally friendly development techniques and work with materials adapted to the site's specific conditions.



ACCOMMODATION & MEALS

You will be accommodated in individual tents provided by Concordia at the Valloire campsite, with access to on-site toilets and showers. The municipality will provide a community hall, located less than 200m from the campsite, where a kitchen and common living area will be set up for meals and group activities. You will share various collective tasks and prepare meals together. A budget will be allocated to the facilitators and you will participate in shopping, favoring healthy and local products and vegetarian food as much as possible. Free Wi-Fi hotspots will be available in certain areas. The establishment also has a washing machine (at your own expenses)



LOCATION & LEISURE ACTIVITIES

Valloire, located in the Savoie department in the Auvergne-Rhône-Alpes region, spans 17 hamlets in the heart of the Maurienne massif, near the Italian border. The main village, at an altitude of 1,400 meters, offers an ideal setting for mountain lovers. For hiking enthusiasts, there are numerous marked trails to explore, including one leading to Lake Cerces, which offers spectacular views. Several lakes with swimming areas allow you to cool off on hot summer days. Heritage enthusiasts can visit iconic sites such as the Fort du Télégraphe and the Notre-Dame-de-l'Assomption church, a listed historical monument.



PARTNER

Since 2022, Valloire has been working with Concordia to organize international volunteer work camps. This partnership is based on shared values: solidarity, civic engagement, and heritage preservation.

TO KNOW

For the work site, bring sturdy clothing suitable for the mountains, such as a fleece, hiking clothes and shoes, a windbreaker, a down jacket, and warm socks. Don't forget sun protection: a hat or cap, sunglasses, and sunscreen. A swimsuit is recommended for water activities. Bring a warm sleeping bag (comfort rating 44-50°F) and a pillowcase.

CHARMING AND LIVING VINEYARD

Pont-du-Château (63)

PROJET & WORK

With seventeen projects underway, the town of Pont-du-Chateau will make you feel right at home! Take part in this major project to restore the terraced gardens, which are gradually being transformed into an eco-friendly place for walking, relaxing, and discovering the landscape. This 3-hectare site features eco-grazing, terraced gardens, a small orchard, a community vineyard, and a playground and relaxation area.

This year, the town of Pont-du-Chateau is inviting us to continue the work begun last year on the vineyard site, to beautify the space and build a retaining wall between the vineyard plot and the park. The program includes removing the old fence, carpentry and woodworking, and other landscaping activities in the park.

ACCOMMODATION & MEALS

Accommodation will be provided on municipal grounds not far from the work site. You will sleep in individual tents on inflatable mattresses (provided by Concordia) on grassy terrain.

The bathrooms and changing rooms will be permanent structures; with communal living and cooking facilities under a large tent reserved for your group. Wi-Fi is available on site. Laundry can be done by hand or at a laundromat in town (paid service).

You will share the various tasks of communal living together. A budget will be allocated to the group and you will participate in shopping and meal preparation, with an emphasis on healthy and local products!



LOCATION & LEISURE ACTIVITIES

Pont-du-Château is a small, dynamic town overlooking the Allier River. The regional capital, Clermont-Ferrand, is 9 miles away and can be reached by train and bus. The castle, nestled in the heart of the town, offers a remarkable view of the Clermont-Ferrand metropolitan area and the volcanoes of Auvergne. You will be welcomed by local associations offering leisure activities such as kayaking, hiking, swimming, an introduction to pétanque, and team sports.

PARTNER

The town of Pont-du-Château is seeking to make nature a priority through sustainable management and the creation of natural spaces. Among the projects, former terraced gardens have been gradually redeveloped by international volunteers into ecological gardens. This sixteenth project in Pont-du-Château is part of this major landscaping project.

TO KNOW

Remember to bring clothes and shoes for work, as well as a good sleeping bag and swimsuit. Nights can be cool, so remember to bring warm clothes. You can also bring recipes from your country/region, musical instruments, and games. Travel will be on foot and occasionally by car and minibus.

DRY STONE IN PROVENCE

PROJET & WORK

Help promote the heritage of stone on the French Riviera! Once again this year, the municipality of Chateaudouble invites you to actively contribute to the restoration of the low walls surrounding the village's outdoor theater.

Your mission? Help clean up the site (weeding, clearing, etc.), sort the stones recovered on site and those provided by the municipality, rebuild sections of the wall using existing stones, and create signage with panels explaining the history of the site. Combining festivities and working in nature, this project is an enriching experience that brings together expertise, creativity, and intercultural encounters!

ACCOMMODATION & MEALS

You will be accommodated in individual tents provided by Concordia on land made available by the municipality of Chateaudouble. You will have access to the communal house with a fully equipped kitchen, which you can use as a living space for the duration of your stay. Toilets and solar showers are adjacent to the communal house.

You will share daily tasks and prepare meals together. A budget will be given to the team leaders, and you will participate in shopping and meal preparation, with priority on healthy, local products. A recipe book will also be provided to encourage responsible purchasing and sustainable eating.

LOCATION & LEISURE ACTIVITIES

Chateaudouble is located in the heart of rural Provence in the south of the Provence-Alpes-Cote d'Azur region, close to rivers and surrounded by magnificent landscapes.

The region offers a calm and sunny setting ideal for walks. Volunteers will also have the opportunity to explore the surrounding area with sports activities (hiking, canoeing on lakes or rivers, outdoor sports, etc.), activities to meet the local population and intercultural exchanges (e.g., shared world meals, pétanque tournaments, etc.).

PARTNER

The municipality of Chateaudouble, located in the Var department in the south of the Provence-Alpes-Cote d'Azur region, has been a Concordia partner since 2022. Always deeply committed to welcoming volunteers and supporting projects, it does everything possible to offer a friendly and enriching stay, marked by intercultural exchanges and a genuine spirit of cooperation and intercultural encounter, particularly with the inhabitants and during the village's summer festivals. The municipality and Concordia also organize the inauguration event for the work site.



TO KNOW

Remember to bring gloves, clothes, security shoes for work, and a swimsuit! Don't forget to bring sun protection (hat, sunglasses, etc.). Nights can be cold, so bring a warm sleeping bag and a groundsheet for extra comfort. Tents will be provided.

You can also bring specialties from your country or region, musical instruments, or games: anything you like and want to share during the project, whether with the local population or with the group of volunteers!

Cessenon-sur-orb (34)

MOSAIC STYLE

PROJET & WORK

Come and discover the art of mosaics ! Your task will be to decorate picnic tables by the river, surrounded by the typical natural landscape of the south of France.

Supervised by a specialist, this artistic workshop will follow on from last year's work on the theme of biodiversity. Mosaic work is fascinating and requires meticulousness, agility, and insight. The resulting artwork will embellish the recreation area while also serving to protect the tables in this sensitive natural space in a sustainable way.

If you love nature and urban arts and are interested in biodiversity, this project is for you!

ACCOMMODATION & MEALS

You will be accommodated in individual tents provided by Concordia near a sports facility. You must bring your own camping mattress and sleeping bag. Toilets and showers will be available inside the sports center. In case of high temperatures, an indoor shelter will be provided.

A municipal space will serve as a living and dining area. Community life will be at the heart of the experience : you will share daily tasks and prepare meals together. A budget will be given to the activity team, and you will participate in shopping and meal preparation, with an emphasis on healthy, local products. Your neighbors will surely treat you to their specialties!

LOCATION & LEISURE ACTIVITIES

The village of Cessenon-Sur-Orb is located north of Béziers in the south of France, halfway between the sea and the mountains. It is home to the Orb River, the area boasts an exceptional natural and cultural heritage !

The surrounding countryside offers a wide range of outdoor sports and activities. The town is located not far from the Mediterranean beaches (35 km). The Reals water sports center is a great place for water activities. You can hike in the famous Gorges d'Héric or Gorges de la Colombière or try your hand at canoeing and kayaking.

PARTNER

For many years, we have had a very strong partnership with the town of Cessenon-sur-Orb, which works to improve the living environment and develop local tourism. This area is intended for residents to relax and socialize, as well as for tourists passing through. This mosaic project contributes to the enhancement of the town.



TO KNOW

PROTECTING HERITAGE 3 & MUSIC FESTIVAL

Clermont-l'hérault (34)

PROJET & WORK

How would you like to work in a real medieval castle? With valuable guidance from your technical supervisor, you will restore a paved courtyard at the foot of the castle keep, known as a "calade." You will discover the ancestral know-how behind this construction technique while playing archaeologist, as many incredible finds have already been made in this castle!

Your job will be to highlight the existing stones in the courtyard and select new ones to give the castle's courtyard a facelift. In addition, you will be asked to carry out small landscaping jobs in the park, but also to lend a hand at the music festival that will set the castle alight during your stay.



ACCOMMODATION & MEALS

You will be accommodated in individual tents provided by Concordia in the grounds of the Chateau des Guilhem, which offers stunning views of the city. You must bring your own camping mattress and sleeping bag. Toilets will be available in the castle outbuildings, and showers will be provided by the sports clubs.

A large tent will be set up as a living space with a dining area. Community life will be at the heart of the experience: you will share daily tasks and prepare meals together. A budget will be given to the activity team, and you will help with shopping and meal preparation, focusing on healthy, local produce.

LOCATION & LEISURE ACTIVITIES

Clermont-l'Herault is a charming little town located north of Montpellier in the south of France. Enjoying a Mediterranean climate and a remarkable natural environment (Lake Salagou, the rivers of the Gorges de l'Hérault nearby), it also has a rich cultural heritage with its castle and cathedral.

In the heart of a preserved setting, you can enjoy outdoor activities and make cultural and festive discoveries.

PARTNER

Since 2015, we have had a very strong partnership with the town of Clermont-l'Hérault. This project to enhance the Guilhem castle contributes to promoting the heritage of the municipality.

PROJET & WORK

Come and help restore an old mill, in a project combining heritage, nature and collective experience.

Located on the banks of the river in the Bilhard Gorges, a beautiful natural setting, you will help clear the surrounding area, clean and maintain the dry stone walls: sorting stones, rebuilding walls and restoring the site to its former glory. Supported by the municipality of Monistrol-sur-Loire, this project aims to breathe new life into this charming Auvergne town.

ACCOMMODATION & MEALS

You will be accompanied by two camp leaders throughout your stay. The accommodation will be located a 10-minute walk from the work site. You will sleep in individual tents and inflatable mattresses (provided by Concordia) on grassy ground, and a large tent reserved for the group will be used for communal living and cooking. The bathrooms will be located a little further away, in the municipal center. Wi-Fi is available on site. Laundry can be done by hand or at a laundromat in town (paid service).

You will share the various tasks of community life together. A budget will be allocated to the group and you will participate in shopping and meal preparation, with an emphasis on healthy and local products.

LOCATION & LEISURE ACTIVITIES

Monistrol-sur-Loire is the second largest town in the Haute-Loire department: surrounded by nature and crossed by the Loire River, which brings calm and freshness. It offers a green and hilly setting, between river and forests, conducive to both tranquility and outdoor activities. The town preserves a beautiful heritage with its medieval castle and old town center, while offering cultural facilities and activities that make it a lively place.

You will be welcomed by the local youth center, which will offer you activities and opportunities to meet young people from the village. In the heart of the Pilat Regional Park, there are many nature activities to enjoy. Breathtaking hikes await you!

PARTNER

In the last week, the association organizes a music festival, a friendly and festive event not to be missed! You will be involved in organizing the festival, building small pieces of furniture and landscaping the courtyard, welcoming the public, etc.

ACCOMMODATION & MEALS

You will be accommodated in individual tents with inflatable mattresses (provided by Concordia) on a site located 10 minutes' walk from the farm, with access to dry toilets on site. Solar showers and dry toilets are available on the farm, as well as communal living areas and a room specifically reserved for project participants. There is no WiFi available, but a washing machine is to be installed on site.

You will share various collective tasks and cooking duties. Meals will be shared with members of the collective and any other volunteers present on the farm. A chef is on hand to prepare delicious menus (mostly vegetarian). Your days will be punctuated by many moments of sharing and community life: communal meals, game nights, lively discussions, and of course, musical moments to relax and socialize!

LOCATION & LEISURE ACTIVITIES

Saint-Arcons-d'Allier is a small town located in the Haute-Loire department in Auvergne, 35 km from Le Puy-en-Velay and a stone's throw from the Allier Gorges. Set in an exceptional location, surrounded by nature, you can't help but admire its beautiful basalt flows.

In your free time, you can enjoy outdoor activities, swim in the rivers, discover the local heritage, or even make music with the collective.

PARTNER

The Grosso Modo association is an artistic and cultural organization in Haute Loire that stands out for its commitment to traditional music with a twist, blending world music with contemporary creations. It supports, produces, and encourages artistic and cultural projects.

TO KNOW:

You will need to bring work clothes and shoes. Please note that lime is corrosive and irritating, so you must wear long-sleeved T-shirts, pants, and closed shoes.

Remember to bring a swimsuit. Nights can be cool, so bring a good sleeping bag and warm clothes. You can also bring recipes from your country/region, musical instruments, and games.

Travel will be on foot, or occasionally by bicycle or car.

La Motte Servolex (73)

PROJET & WORK

Come and enjoy a unique experience between lakes and mountains by joining a volunteer workcamp in the heart of Savoie! In La Motte-Servolex, a charming town near Chambéry, you will be warmly welcomed by local residents and take part in a project combining commitment, learning, and cultural exchange.

The project is divided into several activities depending on the needs of the community. It can be improving a path in a wetland area to make it more accessible, repairing barriers near a school, painting outdoor walls, and creating a mural.

All these activities share the same goal: improving daily life for local residents and people working in the town.

ACCOMMODATION & MEALS

You will sleep in individual tents on mattresses provided by Concordia. You will have access to the building's sanitary facilities and a fully equipped kitchen. You will take part in collective life by sharing daily tasks such as cleaning and organizing group activities.

Meals will be prepared together, on a rotating basis, using locally purchased products. As part of a responsible consumption approach, we will favour a mostly vegetarian diet, with seasonal and locally sourced food, while respecting everyone's dietary needs.

You will have access to essential facilities nearby, including the kitchen, sanitary facilities, and the collective living area. Wi-Fi will be available near public buildings located less than five minutes away. As the camp is in an urban area, you will be able to do your laundry at a local laundromat.

LOCATION & LEISURE ACTIVITIES

La Motte-Servolex offers an exceptional setting between the Alpine mountains and Lake Bourget, France's largest natural lake.

You can go hiking in the mountains, relax on the lake's sandy beaches, or explore the local cultural and historical heritage. Bicycles will be provided by our partner to facilitate daily travel and allow you to discover the surroundings at your own pace. Organized group outings may include bike rides, relaxation by the lake, or outdoor movie nights.

PARTNER

By joining this workcamp, you will actively participate in environmental preservation and improving the living environment of La Motte-Servolex, a young and dynamic town committed to sustainable development issues.

TO KNOW:

Gloves, reflective vests, and protective goggles, will be provided. Bring closed-toe shoes that can withstand mud and dirt. Nights can be chilly, so bring a warm sleeping bag and, if needed, a sleeping pad or extra mattress for added comfort. Pack clothing suitable for varying weather conditions, such as a fleece and rain jacket, as well as sun protection : sunglasses, sunscreen, a hat, and a water bottle. A swimsuit will also be useful for swimming in pools or water sports areas.



WATERFALL IN PROVENCE

Montferrat (38)

PROJET & WORK

Contribute to preserve the local heritage in the heart of Montferrat!

With the aim of restoring the site's hydraulic heritage, an important part of the village's history and life, your project will be to build the water trail:

Creating a path that follows the spring (restoring dry stone walls, creating steps for the path, cleaning the building that houses a very old hydraulic device dating from the 18th century). You will also be invited to collect stories from the inhabitants to retrace the memory of the place and create panels explaining the history of the water trail.

ACCOMMODATION & MEALS

Accommodation will be in individual tents provided by Concordia in the outdoor area of the stadium. This will be a large field with grass and shade from trees. A marquee will be set up on the field with a kitchen area.

Access to the stadium's showers and toilets is included. You will participate in various collective tasks and prepare meals together, either outdoors or under the small covered area. A budget will be allocated to the coordinators and you will participate in shopping, with a focus on healthy and local products.

LOCATION & LEISURE ACTIVITIES


Montferrat (a municipality of around 1,700 inhabitants) is located in the Var department (83) in the Provence-Alpes-Côte d'Azur region. Located just 15 km from Draguignan and 5 km from Châteaudouble, the village stands among wooded hills in a preserved natural setting. The Pierrepont site is about a 15-minute walk from the town center.

Your volunteer work will be punctuated by various cultural and nature-based activities: discovering the region and its specialties, hiking, outdoor sports, activities to meet the local population... and much more!

PARTNER

This project follows on from last year's. With the friendliness and hospitality of its inhabitants, Montferrat and its many village festivals bring a festive atmosphere to the work camp.

Once again this year, the mayor office wishes to focus on restoring the hydraulic heritage at the Pierrepont site. The municipality's elected officials are delighted to welcome a group of young international volunteers to lead this work camp with Concordia!



TO KNOW:

Bring work clothes and security shoes, hiking boots, and a swimsuit. The nights are cold, so bring warm clothes and a good sleeping bag. And don't forget your air mattress or sleeping pad (it's up to you, you'll be sleeping on it)! Tents are provided by Concordia, as well as an air pump for your mattresses. For the sun: don't forget to bring sun protection (hat, sunglasses, sunscreen, etc.). A headlamp (rechargeable if possible), as well as external batteries to recharge the lamps and your phone.

THE MUD CREW: SMASH AND REBUILD

Aigneville (80)

15/07 - 29/07

➔ CODE : CONCF-28024

PROJET & WORK

Discover the village of Aigneville and take part in a project to renovate an old barn and its cob wall (old natural material for walls, including mud and straw (yellow dry grass)).

Your tasks will include removing the existing cob, recovering and making wooden laths, and reapplying wet cob to restore the wall to a clean and solid state. This workcamp is a unique opportunity to learn traditional building techniques while combining skill-building, creativity, and intercultural exchange!



ACCOMMODATION & MEALS

You will be accommodated in individual tents in the garden of Aigneville's small chateau, with access to a future stone guesthouse serving as a living area and dining space.

Sanitary facilities are available in the château building, with showers provided on site.

Community life is at the heart of the experience: you will share daily tasks and prepare meals together. A budget will be allocated to the animation team, and you will participate in shopping and meal preparation, focusing on healthy, locally sourced products

LOCATION & LEISURE ACTIVITIES

Aigneville is located in the heart of the Picardy countryside, about 30 km from Amiens, famous for its Gothic cathedral (UNESCO World Heritage Site) and hortillonnages (floating gardens). The area offers a peaceful, green environment, ideal for walks and exploration.

Volunteers can also explore nearby towns and sites such as Abbeville, Saint-Valery-sur-Somme, Ault, and the Baie de Somme, one of France's most beautiful natural reserves.

In July, local events will brighten the stay: markets, summer festivals, and cultural activities. Together with the animation team, volunteers can organize excursions to discover the local treasures while enjoying relaxation and shared moments.

PARTNER

The municipality of Aigneville and the château owner, located in the Somme, are new partners eager to revitalize this rural village through an international workcamp. This project strengthens intercultural exchange while promoting local heritage.



TO KNOW:

Remember to bring work clothes for the construction site as well as closed-toe shoes. In case of possible water activities, remember to bring a swimsuit.

For accommodation, bring your sleeping bag and a groundsheet for extra comfort. You can also bring specialties, photos, musical instruments: anything you like and want to share during the project, whether with the local population or with the group of volunteers !

DARE THE MOUNTAIN

Freissinières (05)

15/07 - 05/08

PROJET & WORK

The village of Freissinières is home to an old mill dating back to the XVIII century.

As work on the site began last year, you will have the opportunity to complete the building by restoring the four surrounding walls. Regular work on scaffolding, using traditional construction techniques. You will, of course, be assisted by professionals.

But the project doesn't stop there! You will also be responsible for retracing the history of the Viollins mill through an artistic project that you will carry out in collaboration with the village residents.

ACCOMMODATION & MEALS

You will stay in a dedicated area in the heart of the forest where individual tents will be pitched (and provided). Meals will be prepared outdoors. The group will have to build a clay oven for bread, and cooking will be done over a campfire.

To keep food cool, a bucket in the river will serve as a refrigerator. You will share various collective tasks and prepare meals together. A budget will be allocated to the facilitators, and you will participate in shopping and meal preparation, with priority on healthy, local products. A recipe booklet will be provided to encourage responsible purchasing and sustainable eating.

LOCATION & LEISURE ACTIVITIES

The municipality and valley of Freissinières are located in the Hautes-Alpes (05) at the gateway to the Ecrins National Park, in the Provence-Alpes-Cote d'Azur region. The Viollins mill construction site is located downstream from the town in the direction of Freissinières. It is situated on the banks of the Biaysse torrent.

In winter as in summer, this sheltered valley offers a wide variety of activities: exploring the region and its specialties, hiking, outdoor sports, meeting locals and engaging in intercultural exchanges, and more.

PARTNER

This project is being carried out in collaboration with the Freissinières municipality and the Ecrins National Park. The municipality wishes to restore the Viollins mill, a building that is part of the municipality's rural heritage and could also become a shelter for walkers.

The municipality will be responsible for installing the kitchen area, purchasing materials and equipment, preparing the site, applying for building permits, and storing the materials needed to build the framework.

TO KNOW:

Remember to bring gloves, work clothes, and work security shoes. Nights are cool in the mountains, so bring a good sleeping bag, warm clothes and waterproof jackets. A headlamp (rechargeable if possible) is also necessary, as well as external batteries to recharge the lamps and your phone. Please note that you will be in a national park! Be sure to bring environmentally friendly (biodegradable) hygiene products for showers (solar showers).



Viviers (07)

17/07 - 31/07

A HISTORIC RENOVATION



CODE : CONCF-46914

PROJET & WORK

Dive into history and take part in the restoration of the Maison des Chevaliers, a beautiful 16th-century building listed as a Historic Monument. you will learn different traditional building restoration techniques: stone cutting and placement, traditional masonry, repointing and finishing work.

This project is part of a wider programme to restore and enhance the historic town centre, in partnership with the local municipality and heritage specialists. Your participation will help bring new life to this emblematic site and support local community life.

ACCOMMODATION & MEALS

You will be accommodated at Clos Saint Roc, a former cloister dating back to the 13th century, classified as a historic monument. The accommodation is in a solid building with several shared rooms. It is essential to bring your own sleeping bag suited to summer temperatures.

A fully equipped kitchen is available for use, overlooking a charming park. Meals will be prepared collectively, with everyone taking turns cooking, cleaning, and organizing daily activities. Ingredients will be sourced locally, with an emphasis on seasonal and short supply chain products. We promote a vegetarian diet while respecting individual dietary needs and exploring local culinary traditions together.

There is no washing machine on site. However, a laundromat is available about a seven-minute walk away. The cost of laundry services is the responsibility of participants. The accommodation has Wi-Fi access.

LOCATION & LEISURE ACTIVITIES

You will have the opportunity to explore the region outside of work hours. Concordia facilitators will help organize leisure activities in collaboration with the group. Options include local hikes, visits to the market, and cultural excursions.

For swimming, the Viviers municipal pool may be an accessible option to cool off. Natural swimming sites such as Pignedoré Lake in Pierrelatte or the beaches of the Ardèche Gorges are also possible, though they require longer travel times and cannot be planned on a daily basis.

PARTNER

We are pleased to collaborate for the third consecutive year with CICP Viviers, an association dedicated to the preservation and promotion of the historical, monumental, and archaeological heritage of Viviers and its region.

TO KNOW:

Bring strong work clothes that you do not mind damaging, as well as closed, sturdy shoes suitable for a construction site. You will sleep on floor mattresses provided by Concordia, but for extra comfort, you may bring your own mattress if you have one. Also bring a sleeping bag suitable for summer temperatures (comfort around 15°C), a fitted sheet, and a pillowcase (you can fill it with clothes to make a pillow).



Puy-Sanières (05)

22/07 - 12/08

ROOF FRAMEWORK WITH A VIEW



CODE : CONCF-41314

PROJET & WORK

Join us in the village of Puy-Saniere to breathe new life into a hikers' refuge perched above the stunning Serre-Ponçon lake.

Nestled in the wilderness of the Southern Alps, this rustic cabin was once used as a refuge for hunters in the Ecrins massif. Today, surrounded by pine forests and overlooking turquoise waters, it serves as a shelter for hikers and is a symbol of rural heritage and mountain solidarity.

Last year, a group of young people tackled the walls of the cabin, which is missing a frame and a roof, and that's where you come in!

ACCOMMODATION & MEALS

You will be staying at a camp behind the city hall in Puy-Sanieres, where individual tents (provided by CONCORDIA) will be pitched, along with a large marquee containing kitchen equipment and a living area. Access to permanent toilets and solar showers. There is cell phone reception but no WiFi.

Meals will be prepared in the covered kitchen. You will share various collective tasks and prepare meals together. A budget will be allocated to the facilitators and you will participate in shopping and meal preparation, with priority on healthy, local products.

LOCATION & LEISURE ACTIVITIES

Puy-Sanieres is a commune in the south of France located near the southern flank of Mont Guillaume (2,552 m), at the southernmost tip of the Ecrins massif. It is located in the Hautes-Alpes department in the Provence-Alpes-Cote d'Azur region, near Lake Serre-Ponçon.

The hut site is located a few kilometers from the center of the village of Puy-Sanieres on land mainly devoted to gentle tourism activities.

The work camp will be punctuated by leisure activities, such as discovering the region and its specialties, hiking, swimming in the lake and other sports activities, as well as activities to meet the local population.

PARTNER

Together with the Parc des Ecrins, Concordia has decided to set up an initiative in the Puy-Sanieres area in the heart of the mountains. This Concordia project is part of an overall project by the Provence-Alpes-Côte d'Azur delegation to work in the transalpine and Franco-Italian zones. Our aim is to highlight the need to restore dry-stone huts for workcamps.



TO KNOW:

Bring a warm sleeping bag (0°C recommended), as well as waterproof jackets and winter sweaters. Also bring hiking boots. Don't forget your inflatable mattress or sleeping matt. remember to bring security shoes and clothing. For the sun: don't forget to bring sun protection (hat, sunglasses, sunscreen, etc.). A headlamp (rechargeable if possible) is also necessary, as well as external batteries to recharge the lamps and your phone. Please note that you will be in a national park! Be sure to bring environmentally friendly (biodegradable) hygiene products for showers (solar showers).

AROUND THE MILL

Isle (87)

14/08 - 28/08

PROJET & WORK

Help restore an old mill in the charming village of Isle, in the heart of the forest!

You will be specifically working on the mill run, which consists of small walls created to divert the stream and bring water up to the mill to make it work! You will be clearing weeds, strengthening the walls and rebuilding the parts of the wall which have been deteriorated by time.

Some additional missions are also planned, such as building wooden furniture (picnic tables, etc.) and improvements to the surrounding area, alongside the main project to restore the mill run.



ACCOMMODATION & MEALS

You will be accommodated in individual tents provided by Concordia, which will be pitched on a natural area on the premises of the local stadium. You will have access to sanitary facilities, a kitchen and a communal space, in the town's communal sport facilities.

You will be sharing various collective tasks (cleaning, cooking, team activities, etc.) in order to facilitate the management of the workcamp. A budget will be allocated to the campleaders, and you will help with the shopping and preparation of meals, giving priority to seasonal and local products. We want to encourage a vegetarian diet on this workcamp, but will accommodate participants' various diets and we will attempt to discover the local cuisine together. WIFI is available on site, and you will be able to wash your clothes by hand.

LOCATION & LEISURE ACTIVITIES

Isle is a French town located in the Haute-Vienne department in the Nouvelle-Aquitaine region, close to the city of Limoges, famous for its porcelain, but also rich in history and heritage.

The town is proud of its exceptional natural environment. In the town centre, you will find flower gardens, green spaces and leisure facilities, alongside local shops and services. Just a few minutes walk away, Isle reveals a beautiful rural area, shaped by the two valleys of the Vienne and Aurence. Woods, meadows and farms mingle with the many local castles and manor houses in the municipality, while also enjoying the urban dynamism offered by the city of Limoges, just 5 minutes away.

PARTNER

This is the sixth year that Concordia has been involved with the preservation and restoration of this site and volunteers have been working hard to restore the mill's irrigation system. Ultimately, the town wants to bring this place back to life, and be able to reactivate the mill ! Through this project, you'll be helping to preserve the town's old mill, while spending time in nature, and by sharing a human and cultural experience with the town's locals.



TO KNOW:

According to your needs, bring a sleeping bag for cold weather, a mat or a thick sleeping mattress depending on your need for comfort, work clothes, sports shoes, warm and rain clothes, a flashlight, a swimsuit and sunscreen.

Some of the work might imply working in water, so it's **HIGHLY RECOMMENDED** to bring closed hiking type shoes, if possible water resistant, for this workcamp.
