Where ?



Accommodation and food ?

Accommodation in a collective house with another volunteers. Meals will be provide and cook by the participants in turn. We give priority to vegetarian dishes.

Costs ?

No participation fee -Travel costs will be partially covered according to the Erasmus+ calculator



Participative games & workshops (spontaneous, friendly, organised, etc) with the group and local people (interviews, walks, shared international meals, etc.) while also reflections, discussions and research about the ecological impact of our clothing habits and consumption patterns

To conclude our project, **create & co-organise** a slow-fashion show featuring second-hand clothes recovered from thrift shops or clothing relays ; and mount an exhibition! Depending on the creative path we will take together, we'll add photos, podcasts, videos, etc. to our final result
