The program as described (below) offers volunteers a number of activities to increase their soft skills. No one is excluded from our activities: people with fewer opportunities, children, the elderly, and people with special needs who live in the city will be part of our project activities. Even without being a part, they will see that our actions improve their lives as well. Our organization can offer volunteers the opportunity to participate in a number of activities. Volunteers will play a supporting role in organizing activities, workshops, and events. They will be able to design their own activities, organise events focused on the environment, soft and some hard skills.

1-Activities at schools

For the acquisition of soft skills through nonformal education, such as discussions, debates, work in groups, and brainstorming, at secondary schools in Trnava.

2-Workshops for creating your own projects

Youth for Equality helps young people organise their own small or large projects (workshops, events, dialogues, festivals, youth exchanges).

3-Discussion clubs

Youth for Equality organises discussion clubs for local youth, as well as young people coming from abroad who live in Trnava, in the implementation of which volunteers are involved.

4-Office support

Youth for Equality manages its social networks and website and prepares newsletters. All contributions related to the promotion of the organisation's programs and activities.

5-Activities in cooperation with Charity

The charity's mission is to encourage help in cooperation with other church and civic organisations, based on the principles of selfless love.

6-Activities in cooperation with the Library

In cooperation with the library, we would like to organise workshops on critical thinking, meetings of young people and seniors through intergenerational dialogue, and a human library activities.

7-Community activities

Every young person will gain the skills and abilities to identify, create, and connect with a local community through events and activities.

1* Food - each volunteer will receive a monthly 200€, by transfer in his/her personal bank account open after his/her arrival in Trnava. The transfer will be done in advance on the 1st of each month.

2* Pocket money - each volunteer will receive a monthly 180€, by transfer in his/her personal bank account open after his/her arrival in Trnava. The transfer will be done in advance on the 1st of each month.

3*Accommodation - volunteers will be hosted in shared apartments.

4*Transport budget - without counting the amount you actually used for your arrival, you will receive as reimbursement the full amount as 180€, 275€, or 360€ according to the distance the band from your home city to Trnava established by the EU Distance Calculator platform.

5* Health insurance - each volunteer will have to bring his/her own EHIC card = European Health Insurance Card in case you have it plus in addition, each volunteer will be registered and receive free medical insurance for the ESC program called Cigna.

6* Slovakian language courses - 4 hours each month, the volunteers will have face-to-face interactive Slovak language courses provided by mentors.

7* Working plan - each volunteer will work between 5 - 7 hours per day, 5 days per week, weekends will be free or in case the volunteer will work on weekends he/she will receive the free days later, plus will receive a total number of 14 free days during the mobility (2 days every worked month).

8*Youth Pass Certificate - at the end of the mobility each volunteer will receive his/her personal official certificate based on the gained key competencies.

ABOUT TRNAVA / SLOVAKIA

TRNAVA IS ONE OF THE OLDEST AND MOST IMPORTANT CITIES IN SLOVAKIA. IT IS A NATURAL CENTER OF LOWER POVAŽIE, THE SEAT OF THE TRNAVA DISTRICT AND TRNAVA SELF-GOVERNING REGION. WITH A POPULATION OF 65 000 INHABITANTS, IT IS THE SEVENTH BIGGEST CITY IN SLOVAKIA.

TRNAVA IS ONE OF THE OLDEST AND MOST BEAUTIFUL MEDIEVAL TOWNS IN SLOVAKIA. IT WAS THE FIRST TOWN TO BE GRANTED THE PRIVILEGES OF A FREE ROYAL TOWN. IN THE MIDDLE AGES, IT RANKED AMONG THE LARGEST GOTHIC TOWNS IN CENTRAL EUROPE.

TRNAVA COMES CALLED ALSO A "LITTLE ROME" BECAUSE OF THE CHARACTERISTIC COMPLEX OF UNIVERSITY BUILDINGS AND THE MANY PRESENT CHURCHES IN TOWN.

THE CURRENCY IN SLOVAKIA IS EURO (EUR). THERE ARE SEVERAL MONEY EXCHANGES IN TRNAVA.
