LOCAL PARTNER AND WORK

Ihe volunteers are going to design signs and other art work for the Camino Santiago path "Camino del Alba".

The Camino de Santiago, known in English as the Way of St James, is a network of pilgrims' ways or pilgrimages leading to the shrine of the apostle Saint James the Great in the cathedral of Santiago de Compostela in Galicia in northwestern Spain, where tradition holds that the remains of the apostle are buried. The road passes from lots of little town of Spain.

With this project our aim is to provide the Pilgrims a safe and enjoyable travel where there is no risk of losing the path or getting lost. The volunteers will bring joy and aesthetic to these paths with their art. Meanwhile they are walking the path they are going to create little signs and art pieces on this 12km long path, near our location.

For people, who like to be creative, like art work, nature, walking and outdoor, this is a perfect project!





ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD

The accommodation will be in the volunteers' house called "Casa Jazmin". It has three big rooms with bunk beds in each. There are also 3 separate bathrooms and another room with 2 more shower facilites in the house. There is a kitchen and a common room for the volunteers.

Accommodation itself provides basic conditions and the quality of it depend also on cleanliness and contribution of all participants.

There is Wifi in the accommodation but we do not share it with the volunteers as long as it is not essential to increase theteam building and group atmosphere. We

encourage all participants to keep the phone usage in minimum.

The food will be organized by teams with the products provided by the leaders. Each day one team will be in charge of cooking and the other team will be cleaning.



TRAVELING

Best way to arrive to the camp is flying to Alicante (ALC) airport. From the airport there are direct buses to Benidorm bus station.

The other possibility it to arrive to the Valencia Airport (VLC). Even though it is is not as close as the Alicante airport, it is possible to find direct buses to Benidorm.

For the arrangement of the travel form any of these airports, our campleader will contact to the volunteers directly and guide them.

Advance booking in these buses is not necessary so we reccomend to the volunteers to organise their flights and contact with the leader in order to organise the arrival from airport to the meeting point.



WHAT TO BRING

- your passport or identification card

- health insurance card (or additional travel insurance)
- some rain clothes and warm sweaters
- insect repellent
- if you play any instruments you are very welcome to bring it with you
- strong shoes or boots for trekking, clothes to practice sports



- old clothes for work
- Sleeping bag, towel and sanitary product

Remember that if you have any allergies or illnesses bring the medicine that you may need.

And of course, don't forget to bring your motivation and "desire" ③
