Describe the work that the volunteers will do in detail:

To support Power Cup tournament

- To learn about Power Cup
- To help to set up the tournament (to build the playing fields, draw the borders, set up tents, to organize eating and sleeping places, prepare and put out direction signs and others)
- To be a guide for some Estonian, Latvian, Norwegian teams or clubs
- Serving in selling points (grill, sell sausages, sell sweets)
- To take over some basic tournament volunteers' activities (serving in dining hall, cleaning teams), renew sport fields in between games or between days.
- To take part in dismantling of the tournament (to take off fields, to put down the used equipment, to take out all tournament staff from schools (as they served as accommodation area), from sport halls and areas, what were rearranged for tournament purposes.

For LEKO community - sharing EU values

- To present your country (15 min tell, show, do) for LEKO students
- Take part in LEKO Sport Day, grill night
- Take part in Chatting Club in English with LEKO students

To work on own development

- o Get better understanding about European Solidarity Corps
- Learn and act within Finnish culture, to get to know other cultures
- To follow up on your own development within the framework of YouthPass, in an international team.

Details of the accommodation :

Volunteers will live in LEKO school dormitory, 2 people in the room. Toilet is attached to the room, showers are shared 4-5 for 15 rooms (please take your soap, shampoo etc. with you). There are beds, blankets, pillows and beddings and towels in the rooms.

On working days one warm meal will be provided, breakfast and dinner are either served or arranged by volunteers with ingredients provided.

Possible free time activities:

As we will have bicycles and 2 minibuses in use, group of 9 could fit in a bus and travel with that if needed. Free time activities (3 days total) you will decide in the group (so check out

possibilities around Loimaa in 100 km diameter). It could be Old Capital Turku and neighbouring summer town Naantali, industrial town Tampere, or smaller - Forssa town, UNESCO wooden architecture town Rauma, or just day by hiking in parks, go for Frisbee golf, go to sculpture parks (Alpo Jaakola, Engel park) or just be next to lake or sea or something else.

If you are a confident and experienced driver who is willing to drive a minibus in case when needed please take your driving license with you.

Description of the town (closest services) :

LEKO is located in Hirvikoski, village with about 3000 inhabitants, with library, a shop, swimming pool, sport hall, church, medical centre; and 5 km from Loimaa – a town with population almost 16 000, with bigger shops, cafes, movie theatre, hospital. We have a river – Loimaa and beautiful nature around us.
