In General

With our 2024 workcamp program, ijgd welcomes you to send volunteers to our international workcamps in Germany. We offer a wide range of projects in which volunteers get involved in meaningful work and take an active part in the daily decision-making processes of group life.

About ijgd

ijgd is a non-profit, non-denominational organization which has been active in international youth work since 1949. Each year ijgd organizes international youth workcamps in Germany. In cooperation with partner organizations of the Alliance a worldwide network has been created, so that volunteers can participate in workcamps all over the world. However, this program will focus on workcamps in Germany. Our aim is to encourage young people to become aware of existing social and environmental conditions, enabling them to become an active and responsible participant in a democratic society. This learning process leads (among other things) to the examination of one's own cultural norms and values. Consequently, it will help break down barriers between people which have been built on cultural, social and ethnical differences. This development of international understanding is regarded as a contribution to the furtherance of world peace.

ijgd is a registered charity and does not have a political, religious or institutional affiliation. ijgd receives funds from the European Union and from the German Ministry for Youth.

ijgd Workcamp Conditions

- **Age limit:** Participants are usually between 16 to 26 years (except Teenage-Camps 14-17 years and camps that are explicitly only from 18-26). ESC Projects are open from 18-30. We can't do any exceptions regarding the mentioned age.
 - **Minors** (under 18 years) need written permission (which they must bring to the camp!) from their guardians. PA will be attached to the infosheet
 - BUT: we decided to charge the regular teenage fee of 150€ for volunteers under 18 who apply for our mixed-aged camps. We had to decide this, as our Camps became younger and younger and 18+ volunteers applied less. But also, for our leaders it became more and more a challenge with more than 50% Teenagers in every camp!
- **Camp language:** English is the camp language in most ijgd camps. **It is important that volunteers speak at least basic English!** If the camp language is not English, a special mention is made in the project description.

- **Work:** Volunteers will work about **30 hours a week** (for example six hours a day, five days a week). Weekends are free. Exceptions are mentioned in the descriptions and are made according to the needs of the project.
- **Accommodation:** Accommodations will usually be in schools, gyms, youth centres, scouts huts or similar. In general, there are **basic conditions but all facilities** like kitchen, toilets and showers are available. If not, it is mentioned in the description.
- **Camp Leaders:** Usually, our camps have **two camp leaders**, trained through ijgd seminars, which will support the organisation of free time activities, keep an account for the money for food and free time activities as well as provide some support to group processes. Due to the principal of self-organization, leaders should not have a leadership role, rather be a participant themselves. They are also responsible for the contact to the project's partners, to take care of administrative details and to ensure self-organization of the group. Apart from these responsibilities, they are **volunteers** like the others.
- **Food:** In most work camps, **meals are prepared in a self-organised manner by participants**. The group cook together (in cooking teams). Money for the food shopping is provided. Vegetarian or vegan meals are possible.
- **Insurance:** All relevant insurance (personal accident, illness, third liability) is provided only within the official camp dates. EU volunteers are not insured against illness, that's why they **have to bring** the European Health Insurance Card EHIC. We strongly recommend to (non-EU) volunteers who plan to travel beyond these dates to bring their own insurance.
- **COVID-19:** There are not any rules or requirements regarding covid or covid vaccination

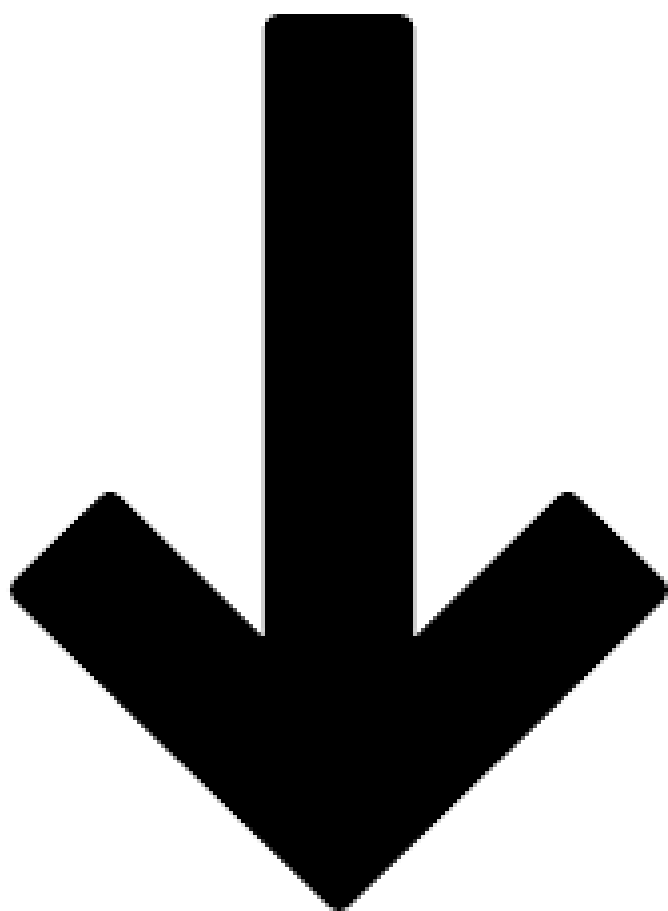
Important Notes:

- Camps are usually for volunteers aged between 16/18 and 26 (no exceptions for older or younger volunteers possible)!
- Volunteers need to reach the age at the beginning of the camp, due to insurance reasons. Should the requested age not be reached at the beginning of the camp, we will have to reject the volunteer (even after confirmation) → Please check before sending the application!
- Volunteers who need a visa have to send their passport number with their application! Please check before sending the application!
- We need an emergency contact from ALL volunteers, but especially minors! → Please check before sending the application!
- This year all our camps are multinational (no tri - / bilateral camps)
- We kindly ask ALL volunteers to fill our Medical Fact Sheet
- In Plato: Number of volunteers is always mentioned without 2 camp leader spots, here: total amount of volunteers (including 2 leaders)
- We try to send a **Free Places List** every Friday. You will receive the **Specific Infosheet** weather together with the acceptance of the application of your volunteer or latest 4 weeks before the project starts.

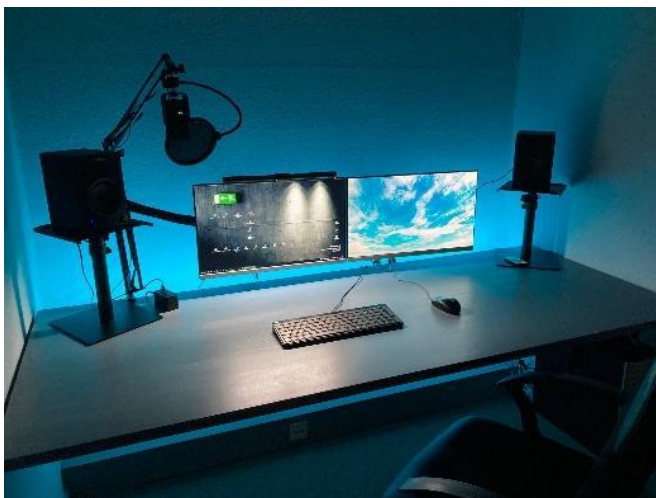

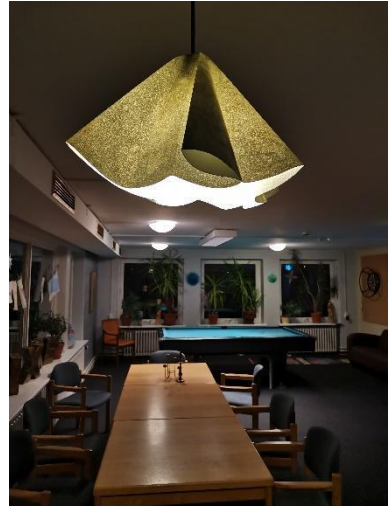

Would you like to learn circus acrobatics, pass on what you have learnt to children and perform together with the children in a circus show in front of a large audience?

The work part begins on Sunday 13th of October: together with the other workcamp participants, you will help to set up a large circus tent on the grounds of the youth centre. From the following Monday to

Friday, the entire workcamp group will receive circus training in the tent from a professional circus trainer.

In the second week, from Monday to Friday, you will pass on the skills you have learned to children from Ahrensburg as part of the local holiday programme. On Friday evening, the children will perform what they have learnt together with you in a circus show with a large audience in a big circus tent.

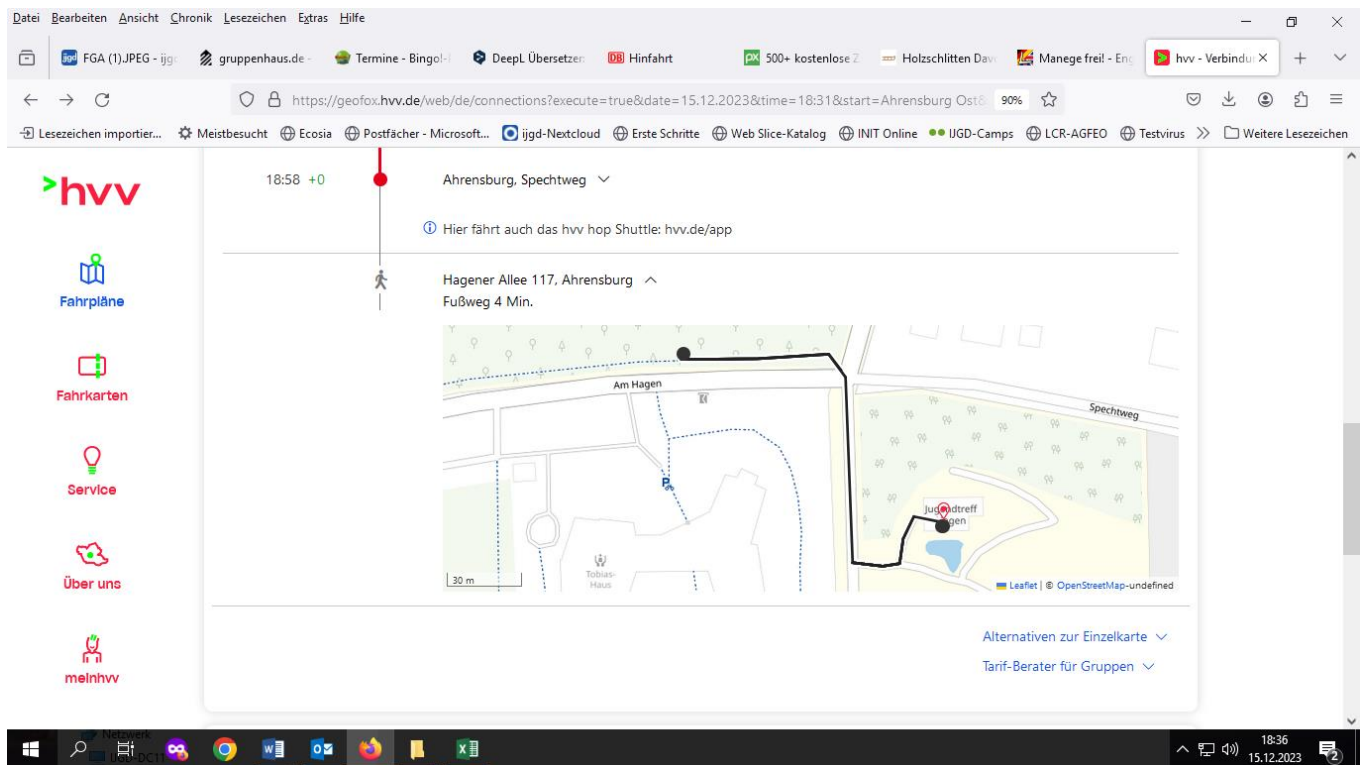
