The target groups are children and young people from 7 to 30 years with a focus on the age of 18 to 27 years.

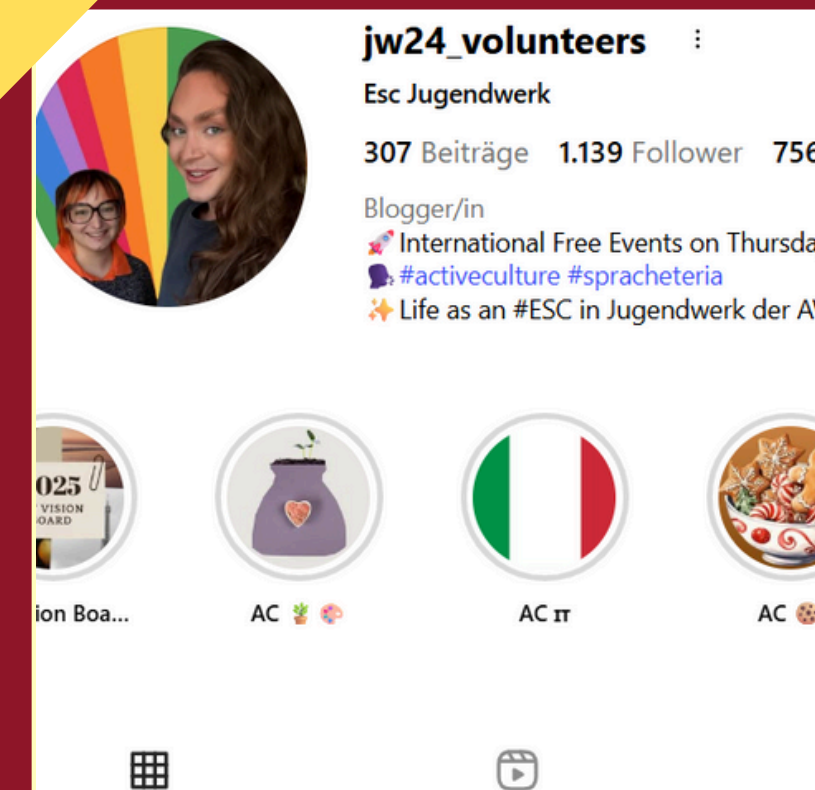
