1: **Monumental Manor Oosterhouw**; cleaning up and helping restore the gardens, like digging and levelling to gardening such as weeding and pruning to wood shredding and splitting. 10 min bike from Group accommodation holiday camp.

2: This **refugee centre** has a capacity for about 600 refugees; The children you will be working with are between 4 and 12 years. This type of work calls for creative people who can make up all sorts of games from scratch to play with the children: music, sports, arts, language sessions, creativity, etc. 30 min bikeride and sleeping in a tent.

3: **Emmaus Haarzuilens** is a live/work community for former homeless people. Volunteers will not only work, but also live together with the inhabitants of Emmaus Haarzuilens. The work will be picking up second hand goods together with the Emmaus residents, sorting them and placing them in the shop, with gardening and help in the kitchen as well. At the end of the project the volunteers will help with the set-up and dismantling of the festival and they will also organize a fashion show in which they will present some of the second-hand clothes that are for sale. You will stay in a comfortable accommodation at the Emmaus terrain.

4: **State Forestry Drentsche Aa** is a project with a unique combination of a 3-day training and 2 weeks of volunteering. Travel and Visa cost will be reimbursed. The training activities will help the team building of the group, the meaning of sustainability and the environment as the volunteering will focus on personal development. The participants will do different activities of nature protection like cutting, dredging, pilling up the paths and haymaking. The accommodation will be in tents

5: **National Park Meinweg** is a beautiful piece of nature of approximately 1800 hectares. It is located in the easternmost corner of Central Limburg and is enclosed on three sides through Germany. Animal supply (2 times a day: feeding, giving water, checking whether everything is fine with the animals)
Maintenance work (pasture fences, bite protection of the trees, animal shelters, etc.)
Fruit harvest - depending on the yield and ripening period. Volunteers stay at the nature protection station.

6: **Steam Train Railway Line**: the volunteers will be spending two weeks in the area of Simpelveld and the surroundings of the steam train trajectory. Two weeks of having fun, working at the cultural heritage of steam trains, historical railway stations, museum, beautiful trajectory from Kerkrade to Simpelveld in a beautiful green and hilly environment. The work: environment, painting bridges and maintenance historic stations. The volunteers are not allowed to work at the historic trains itself. That is only for certified volunteers. The Scouting St. Lucia club building consists of 3 rooms of which 2 of them will be used as bedrooms. We organize separate bedrooms for ladies and for men and we provide the rooms with field beds.
