



There are many reasons to choose Santiago as your study trip destination:

• Beautiful town with a **great historical and artistic value**. World Heritage Site by UNESCO, with one of the biggest and best preserved historic centres in Spain. The monumental area is pedestrianized and keeps its medieval structure, with narrow streets and colonnades.

• Small: 90,000 residents. Very **safe, quiet and welcoming**. A really friendly city.

• Home to one of the **oldest universities in Spain** (35,000 students) and it is the **end of the** *Camino de Santiago*. A **young and exciting** city: a third of its population are university students.

• A cultural and leisure offer that lasts all year round, with yearly programmes in auditoriums, theatre halls, museums and on the city's streets and squares: *Cineuropa* in November; concerts for every taste during the *Apóstol festivities* in July; traditional celebrations along the streets on *Saint John's* night in June; open air dance festival in June...

• Very well located, equidistant from the main cities in Galicia and with good communications to them. It is also one hour away from the best beaches in the North of Spain. Good connections with the North of Portugal.

But especially, Santiago de Compostela is **lesser known as destination for linguistic trips**. It does not suffer the saturation of foreign students which happens in other more traditional destinations.

Intensive programs. Face to Face OR Online

Now, our Intensive Courses are also available online. Through our Hybrid Classroom, students can follow the course from their homes, ineracting both with the teacher and with their in-person classmates.

Intensive Course 20

20 group lessons per week. There is a $\frac{1}{2}$ hour coffee break every day.

Intensive course 25

25 group lessons per week. Same structure as the *Standard Course 20*, but with 5 extra lessons per week, focused on improving oral communication.

Intensive course 25 + 5

25 group lessons + 5 one-to-one hours (x 60 minutes), dedicated to work on those aspects of the language that need to be reinforced or to improve oral communication skills. This course is approved as *Bildungsurlaub*.

One to one course

From 2 to 6 hours of class per day (x 60 minutes), focusing only on the student's need.

Groups have an average of **5** students and a maximum of **8** (maximum of 10 in June, July and August). See "Course Conditions" for low enrolment conditions.

Spanish + Internship program

Consists of a Spanish Language course combined with an unpaid internship held in local companies of different sectors.

•Minimum age to participate: 17. Minimum level of Spanish required to start the internship: B1.

Programs for groups. Face to Face or Online

We offer a wide variety of programs for groups of students from the same high school/liceo/Gymnasium, university or adult education center, accompanied by at least one group leader. Free accommodation for group leaders.

Spanish Language & Culture

A combination of 4 daily lessons (= 3 hours) of Spanish Language & Culture plus a varied activity program.

MINIMUM LENGTH: 1 WEEK.

Spanish for Specific Purposes (valid as PCTO for Italian schools)

Programs combining specific-purpose language training with practical activities such as visits to companies, research projects and professional workshops (in collaboration with chambers of Commerce and international business schools.

Italian schools can certify up to 40 PCTO hours per week.

MINIMUM LENGTH: 1 WEEK.

Spanish + Internship

For groups from high schools, vocational training schools or universities of the European Union involved in a mobility project under the frame of Erasmus+ Programs.

MINIMUM LENGTH: 2 WEEKS.

In Santiago de Compostela there are many things to do or to see: concerts in all the historic district squares during the summer, many of which are free; museums; all kind of exhibitions... We will inform the students about everything happening in Santiago.

Furthermore, Iria Flavia organizes **at least 3 free activities weekly**. These activities will take place provided that at least 5 students register for them. In the summer the average is of 4 activities a week.

Some examples of free activities are:

- The first day we invite the students to a drink and tapa in the historic district. This activity is
- carried out only on starting dates if there are at least 5 students beginning the course.
- Tour around the most traditional handicraft shops.
- Gastronomic routes.
- Visits to museums, exhibitions, historic buildings.
- Tour of parks and gardens.
- Attending to concerts, cinema, theatre...
- Commented movies.
- Spanish music samplings.
- Afternoons of popular Spanish games (cards, table games)
- Workshops: theater improvisation, creative writing, nonverbal communication.
- Seminars on Spanish and Galician culture and traditions.

ESP

There are other activities for an additional fee, like:

- Excursions to the beach, to the Atlantic Isles National Park, to fishing villages, to other cities, to historic places, to Northern Portugal...
- Trekking around the city.
- Tapas tour.
- Tasting wines and typical products.





- All lodgings are at a maximum walking distance of 30 minutes from the School.
- Double rooms are only available for students travelling together.

• Accommodation in shared appartment is provided from the Sunday before the course starts until the Saturday after the course ends. Students arriving earlier or leaving later can book 1 or 2 extra days; 3 or more extra days will be charged as a whole week.

- Any reasonable complaint about the accommodation will be seen to in 24 hours.
- All prices are final, with no hidden costs.

• Students who withdraw from IF housing before the completion of the course will receive no housing refund.

 Accommodation supplement for acompanying people (friends or relatives not attending a course at Academia Iria Flavia): €50 per week.

Spanish Families

Single or double rooms. Half board (breakfast + lunch) or full board. Lightweight laundry included.

Apartment (shared with other students)


Available year-round. Accommodation in shared appartment is provided from the Sunday before the course starts until the Saturday after the course ends. Students arriving earlier or leaving later can book 1 or 2 extra days; 3 or more extra days will be charged as a whole week. Double or single rooms, equipped with a desk and heating. Wi-Fi, washing machine and fully equipped kitchen. Cleaning service once a week in common areas; students must clean their own bedrooms and change their bed linen and towels (both are provided by the school).

Student Residence

Very centrally located (about 10-15 minutes walking to the school). Single or double rooms, shared bathrooms. The rooms are equipped with a desk, wardrobe, TV and WiFi. Daily cleaning service. Towels and bed linen provided.

Available with full board or half board (breakfast + lunch). Breakfast is prepared by the students themselves in the residence kitchen (the residence provides the ingredients: milk, coffee, bread and butter...). Lunch and dinner are cooked and served to the students in the residence's dining room.

Private Apartment & Hotel











Any eventual change in the arrival date or time must be communicated to our office.

For host family accommodation: the student must go directly to the host family's home, where the hosts will be waiting for him/her.

For apartment accommodation: the student must go directly to the apartment, where the accommodation manager will be waiting for him/her.

- From the airport: a taxi to the accommodation costs about €22. A bus to the city centre (leaves every 30 minutes) costs €3.
- From train or bus station: both are located in the city centre. A taxi to the accommodation costs about €7.

If you have booked a pick-up service at the airport through Academia Iria Flavia (cost one way, per person: €30) a chauffeur will be waiting for you at the arrival hall with a sign with your name on it.

Arrival to the school

You will get a message with the student's class schedule. Before the beginning of lessons, students will get the most important information about the School, the schedule, the activity program... together with a map of the city.

Any student who has not completed the placement test previously, will have to do it on the first day.















Booking procedure and payment

Conditions of enrolment are those quoted in our brochure and website. Enrolments must be sent to Academia Iria Flavia on-line or by e-mail. **We advise to send the bookings in time (at least 2 weeks in advance)**, especially when booking any type of accommodation. We at Academia Iria Flavia will make all possible efforts to match bookings received at a shorter notice, but **it will always depend on availability of places**.

All banking fees must be paid by the student / agent.

Cancellations

- For cancellations received more than 20 days in advance to the starting date, all payments made will be refunded.
- For cancellations received between 19 and 7 days in advance, all payments made will be refunded, excluding the deposit (150 €), which will be used as administration expenses.

• For cancellations received less than 7 days in advance, a 50% of all payments made, excluding the deposit (150 €), will be refunded.

• No refunds will be made to students leaving the course after it has started, except when special circumstances occur.

• All refunds will be made to the agent.

• All cancellations must be notified in written. All banking costs incurred will be deducted from the refund.

Course Conditions

All General Programs and Spanish + Internship Program are subject to a **minimum booking of 3 students**. If there are less than 3 students enroled at one level, lessons will be reduced in order to keep the course running. In this case, the students will receive the following number of lessons:
