From there take a bus to Quitumbe bus station. The last bus leaves the airport at 19:00. The cost is 3.00 USD.

In the Terminal Quitumbe please take a taxi to the Fundacion's house, the taxi drivers know our address. The cost varies between 5 to 6 USD depending on the transit.

**By taxi:** You can take a taxi directly from the airport to the Fundacion's house for 30 USD. We can book a taxi for you, just let us know before your arrival, in
