La Riba is a youth camp used as a camping ground, open year-round for children and youth. During this project, participants will help maintain and improve the camping grounds by renovating common areas, repairing facilities, cleaning and organizing spaces, and helping with landscaping and outdoor upkeep. These tasks ensure that the camp remains safe, welcoming, and in excellent condition for future visitors.

Young volunteers will take part in a hands-on heritage project. They will help preserve this historic space through tasks such as repainting doors, building stone walls, painting fences and creating small stone constructions. The project also offers the opportunity to connect with the local community and make a meaningful cultural and social experience.
