Project objectives

- To provide youth leaders and current/potential board members from across Europe with the skills, knowledge and tools to become effective leaders of their organisations;
- To enrich participants' work and make them competitive on a job market;
- To promote young people's active participation in decision-making process;
- To support our member organizations through capacity-building and explore together how to lead youth organisations;
- To enhance the multicultural approach as well as tolerance and solidarity of participant through providing learning space for young people from countries that are different from one another;
- To provide youth leaders and current/potential board members with a European perspective on youth work;
- To provide space for young leaders to talk and share good practices on how to deal with the current EU crises;
